Please join us in welcoming Professor Akira "Lazy Cat" Murakami from Akita University in Japan, who will be in Bolinas next week on a U.S. tour to talk about the uncensored news from post-Fukushima Japan.

The story of why he is coming to Bolinas is an interesting one. Some of you may remember that last November, we reported in the Hearsay that the EON team had participated in an action at the Japanese Consulate in San Francisco, where we presented them with 7,000 signatures in an international petition asking the Japanese government to stop their plan to distribute and incinerate radioactive rubble all over their country. We had been asked by Japanese activists to help them put pressure on the Japanese government to stop this crazy plan of spreading the radiation even further instead of containing it as much as possible.



The petitions were presented to the consul with flowers & condolences.

At the consulate, EON's Jim Heddle videotaped the action and put it on YouTube. It was then translated into Japanese and was widely viewed in Japan- with over 15,000 views in the first week. As result of this video, we were contacted by Professor Murakami, asking if he could visit us while in the United States for Fukushima anniversary events. We are honored and delighted to be hosting him in the Bay Area next week, with public events in Bolinas and in Berkeley and numerous radio shows and interviews.
