Good Will Hunting (1997)

This is a blast from the past for sure, but it's one of my favorite films, with original Screenplay Oscar winners Ben Affleck and Matt Damon. I'll never forget how happy and excited they were when they won that well deserved Oscar. It's what they said ended their couch surfing days. I also enjoyed it because the two are best friends in real life, and have been since ages 8 and 10 respectively, growing up in Boston. Ben's younger brother Casey Affleck has a part, and he has come into his own having an Oscar nomination for his lead in Manchester By the Sea last year. It was produced by Matt Damon, and I will review it next time. Anyway, in this film Matt Damon stars as Will Hunting, a smart ass janitor with equally smart ass pals. He's a closet mathematical genius and one night on the job, his abilities get discovered by one of the college professors (Stellan Skarsgard). He enlists the help of former classmate (the late great Robin Williams, who won for his role), to break through the tortured soul of the young Will. This film has it all. 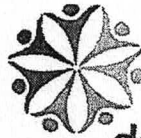
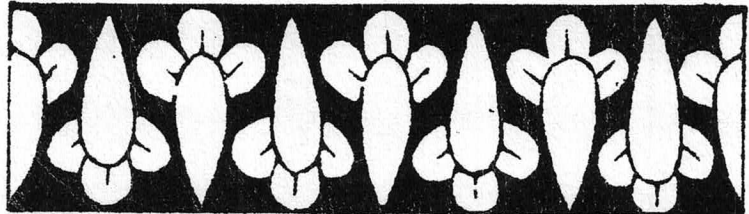

the slopes of Mt Tamalpias.

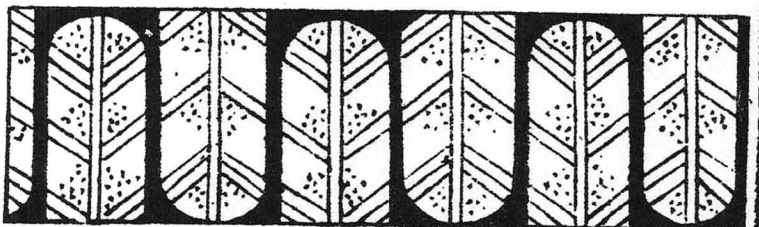
These are mostly songs arising out

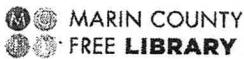

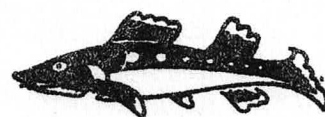

Hitler's Messenger

FreeBox Follies 2019 -Rising Up! February 23rd.

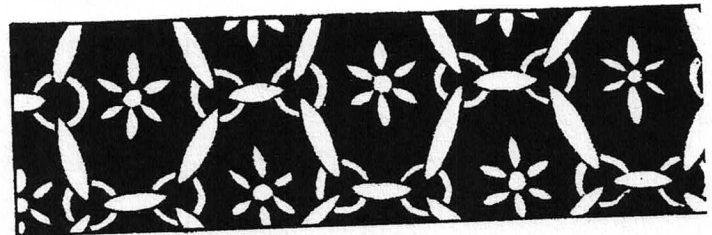
For 11 years the Freebox Follies has used me to helm an only in Bolinas experience, the Freebox Follies. Last year someone said if I was not doing everything I have done to keep the Freebox Follies happening that some one else would show up and do it, I guess it is time to find out if that is true. So this is my last year and I am hoping that person is ready and will just stand up now.

The week before my first Freebox Follies my coproducer came to tell me that we should cancel because we did not really have a show, and I said "No!". I said that we were doing something beyond just putting on a show. We were creating a space for for anyone who wanted to claim themselves as Freebox to come make a living Freebox donation and give it away in public.

The idea of giving of your time, imagination, and connectivity to "Community" in complete faith that community is there. That's the fuel for the Freebox Follies. That has created more than 10 years of every show being fully new and raw. That is what had me putting hundreds of requests for collaboration in the Hearsay over the years, that is what had one or two individuals show up and give oxygen and fuel to the possibility every year. I am hoping that Don Smith will be willing to do light and sound, that Omar will dj, as for MC...that is a magic spot that I think has been cherished by everyone that has done it. Ship of Dreams: Artists, Poets, & Visionaries of the S.S. Vallejo (1949-1969)

Bolinas Museum
New Exhibitions Openings
Saturday, January 12

This exhibition shares the story of a ferryboat, the S.S. Vallejo, docked in Sausalito, and the vibrant community that gathered there; artists, musicians, philosophers and writers who became national counter-culture icons. This community cross-pollinated with the hippie intellectual culture, some were organizers of the 1967 Human Be-In at Golden Gate Park and many participated in the literary and art Renaissance of the 1970s in Bolinas. Among the luminaries who are part of the S.S. Vallejo history are such diverse characters as **Alan Watts, Gary Snyder, Maya Angelou, Ravi Shankar, Wolfgang Paalen, Adeline Kent, Lawrence Ferlinghetti, Allen Ginsberg, Henry Miller, Ruth Asawa and Marcel Duchamp**. At the center of this circle of creativity were the owners of the ferryboat, artists **Jean Varda and Gordon Onslow Ford** whose colleagues included such artists as André Breton and Picasso. This exhibition of artworks, photographs and memorabilia debuted at the Sonoma Valley Museum of Art curated by Linda and David Keaton with assistance from the Lucid Art Foundation in Inverness.

In 1957 Gordon Onslow Ford and his writer wife, Jacqueline Johnson, bought land on Inverness Ridge and invited several artists to build homes there too. That generosity created a legacy of creativity, through sculptor J.B. Blunk, many of the co-founders of Gallery Route One, the Lucid Art Foundation (co-founded by Onslow Ford, Robert Anthoine and artist and scientist Fariba Bogzaran), and next generation artists such as Bruce Mitchell, Rick Yamamoto, and J.B. Blunk's children Rufus and Bruno Blunk and Mariah Nielson.

Blunk Brothers: Paintings and Sculptures by Bruno and Rufus Blunk, curated by Mariah Nielson, is featured in the Coastal Marin Artists gallery. The children of J.B. Blunk grew up on Inverness Ridge surrounded by art, artists and nature, then expanded their experiences with world travel. The result is seen in their paintings and sculptures that reflect their curiosity, playfulness and independence.

In the Permanent Collection Gallery, is a selection of work from artists who were working at the same time as their associates on the S.S. Vallejo. They were unique innovators in the Bay Area and participated in the early development of modern art through photography, and surrealism, expressionism and abstraction in art. Many were also social activists. Among the artists are former Bolinas residents Mary Lindheim Louie Siegriest, Franciena Terebova, and Erwin Manhiem.

We are pleased that we will have important contributors to this group of exhibitions at the opening reception including **Linda and David Keaton, Fariba Bogzaran, Mariah Nielson and Rufus Blunk**. Also, please note there are upcoming special events related to these exhibitions. **Gallery Talks are at 2 PM, Opening Reception 3-5 PM. Opening receptions, like entry to the exhibitions, are always free.**
