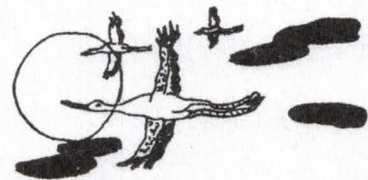

I'm urging anyone who has not registered to vote to do so... and then vote! Michael Moore in his new movie points out that the largest voting block we have in the US is *Non-Voters*. - The deadline to register online is Monday, October 22.
- The deadline for registering to vote by mail is Monday, October 22.
- The deadline to register to vote in person is Tuesday, November 6. Conditional voter registration is a safety net for Californians who miss the October 22 deadline to register to vote or update their voter registration information. Voters can use the conditional voter registration process from October 23 all the way through Election Day. Eligible citizens can go to their county election office or a designated satellite location to register and vote conditionally. These ballots will be processed once the county elections office has completed the voter registration verification process.

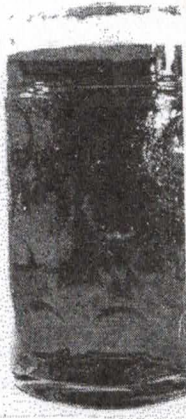

Dear Community,

Some of you have expressed concern, and disappointment that Karen Green of Om Garden was given notice that her lease would not be renewed for 2019. We shared your sentiment and reached out to find another viable solution for the office needs of our rapidly growing Bolinas Community Land Trust. Commonweal has generously agreed to rent us a space temporarily until we are able to find something that will work for our expansion long term. We are happy to tell you that Karen will have a lease come January!

On a different subject, the BCLT board made an agreement last year, that whenever we purchase or acquire property, we will let the entire community know within two weeks. We are happy to announce that we now own the two adjoining lots, one property in, on the West side of Aspen Rd. heading towards Poplar Rd. We hope to build two structures there that will be available to low-income residents through some kind of cooperative home ownership program, the details of which have not yet been determined. We know that there is some resistance to this development within the community and will do our best to be thoughtful and careful in our process and procedures. At this time we will be going into the land to dig some "test pits" to determine if we can put in a septic. Nothing more will be done until this is known.

Our gas station repairs are complete and we are now selling premium again. We have taken out a large loan to get this work done as we feel providing gasoline to our community is an essential service. We are expecting our new pumps to be installed in the next 6 -8 weeks and look forward to future beautification of the entire gas station area. We apologize for the long wait.

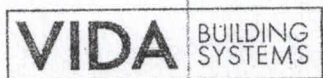

**Free Toxic Away Day – Bolinas**

On Saturday, October 27, Marin County residents will be able to bring their household hazardous waste (HHW) to the Bolinas Toxic Away Day for free disposal. The event will be held from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. at Mesa Park next to the Bolinas Fire Station at 100 Mesa Road in Bolinas. **Appointments are required for residents who wish to participate in the event.**

Examples of HHW that will be collected include old computer monitors, household batteries, paints, stains, thinners, fertilizers, pesticides, adhesives, gas, motor oil, antifreeze, pool chemicals, and household cleaners. No commercial waste will be accepted. Residents can bring a total of 15 gallons of liquid waste or 125 pounds of dry waste.

**To schedule an appointment, call 1-800-207-8222 and press 204.** Space is limited to a 60 car maximum. If you are unable to participate in the drop-off event, you may bring your HHW to the permanent Marin HHW Facility. The HHW Facility, located at 565 Jacoby Street in San Rafael, is open Tuesday through Saturday from 8 am to 3:30 pm and serves all residents of Marin County, excluding Novato.

West Marin Toxic Away Days are a convenient, safe, and free way for residents to dispose of their household hazardous waste to avoid accidents and illegal dumping. This free event is sponsored by the San Rafael Fire Department, the Bolinas Fire Protection District, the Bolinas Community Public Utility District, and Zero Waste Marin.
