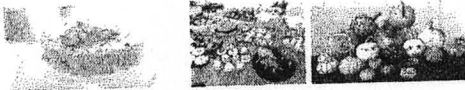

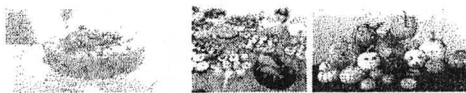

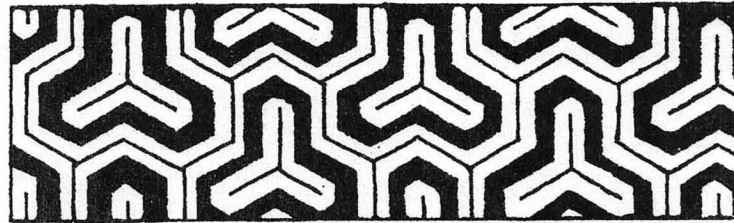

Seven years after I was born in Los Angeles my family moved north to Belvedere when the Tiburon peninsula was still mostly dairy ranches and Tiburon was a working railroad town.

During my five years studying Architecture at the University of Oregon I took on partial paraplegia from an ill-advised cliff dive on the Oregon coast, married Margaret and became a father to Megan.

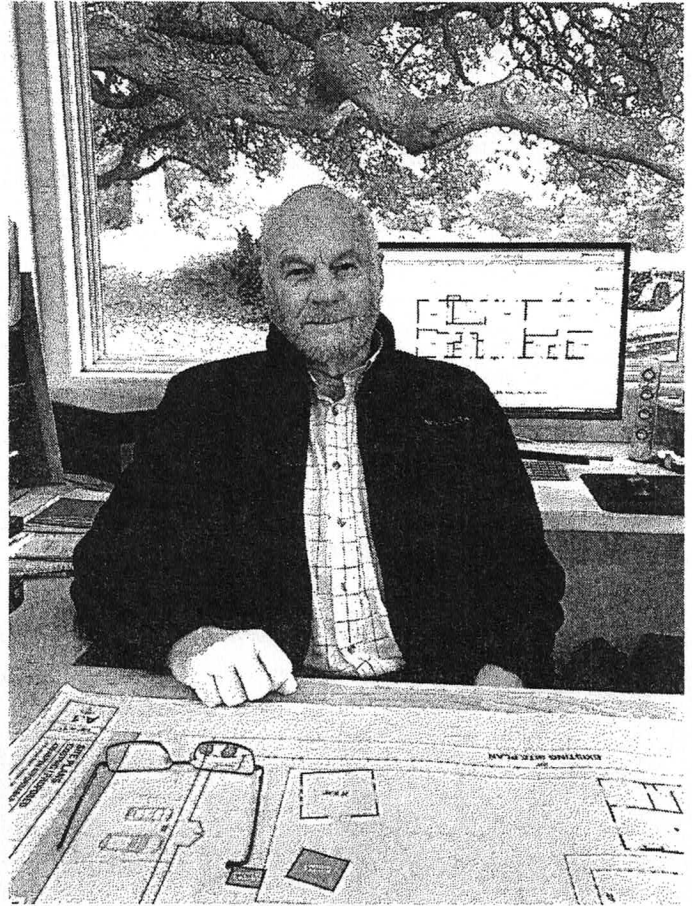
Following the marriage's breakup and while working with a planning firm in San Francisco I moved to Bolinas in 1970 to a house on a vanishing site on Ocean Ave and soon became involved in the heady politics of post oil-spill Bolinas. My experience as head of a team planning the Northstar village and ski resort (shame?) led me to help form the Bolinas Planning Group which went on to write the Bolinas Community Plan.

I joined the BCLT board in 2004 because I saw an opportunity to contribute my professional experience to the transformation of 6 Wharf into affordable housing. I helped with the design of the site plan and live-work spaces and, later, designed the townhouse duplex: The Land Trust's first development of family housing.

Currently, I am preparing drawings for county planning applications for our Overlook and 430 Aspen projects which represent our next effort at producing affordable family housing.

Daily awareness of my extraordinary - at times surreal - good fortune of where I live, where my three grandchildren have grown, and of Bolinas's greatest threat, its sorry lack of affordable housing, keeps me involved in the often tedious, yammering and absolutely necessary work of the BCLT. Since first moving to Bolinas I have also lived in Hawaii, England and Thailand with never a thought of not returning.

Ask him. He knows.

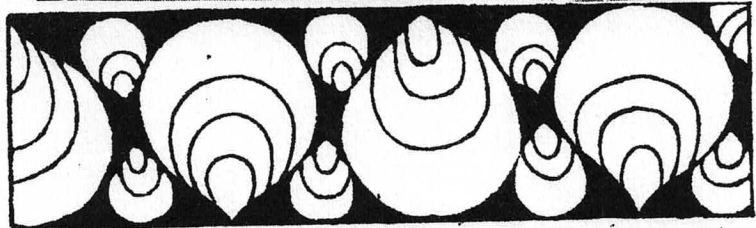

Fees no longer apply and now saving accounts will accumulate funds.

Meeting adjourned 6:00.

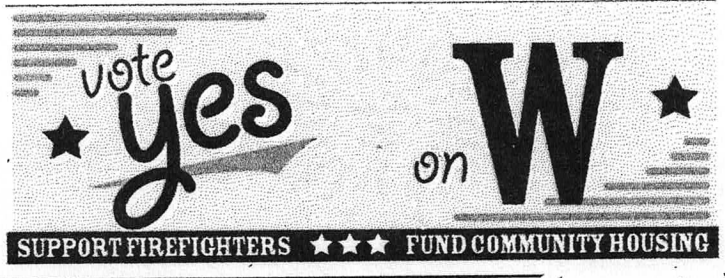
