130 years ago, Frank Waterhouse bought 130 acres of farm Land from Jose Briones for \$6,500. He cut a road to the beach, Brighton, followed by Terrace, Park & Newport and subdivided 50-foot lots throughout, reserving one acre for a park on Brighton. He named his rural subdivision Granda Vista and advertised it over the hill. Having built paradise, Frank couldn't keep out the tourists. He even put a locked gate on Brighton but many people felt Bolinas could not afford such an insult. A feisty man, generally disliked, Frank was never a part of the folksy in-mixture that was Bolinas society. His daughter, Marin, would later open a bathhouse for summer people on the beach.

## 40 YEARS OF BOLINAS HEARSAY NEWS EXHIBIT OPENING & CELEBRATION SATURDAY NOV.15, 2-4PM

Please join us in the Bolinas Museum courtyard to celebrate the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary year of the *Bolinas Hearsay News*. Established in 1974 with the concept "everyone is a reporter", it is a uniquely democratic publication. Anyone can contribute to the Hearsay as long as submissions are signed and do not contain slander or libel. It is still produced three times a week with a different staff for each day. Today's Hearsay staff members are the continuation of a remarkable forty-year legacy of creative people who have made this paper possible, along with the support of local businesses and all of us.

*Hearsay News*, a name suggested by poet Lewis McAdams, was founded by Michael Rafferty, who became the town butcher at Bolinas Market in 1971. He says, while on the job he got to know every carnivore in town--and vegetarians who bought cheese. Rafferty, with degrees in literature and an immense sociological curiosity, listened to people and thought there might be interest in local news. Now, forty years, a huge family of staff past and present, thousands of contributors and more than 50,000 pages later, the Hearsay is still vibrant, and available on paper or online.

To celebrate the remarkable longevity of this very unconventional newspaper, the Bolinas Museum and *Bolinas Hearsay News* collaborated to present a history room exhibit that includes every issue of four decades of the Hearsay in bound volumes for you to peruse. Issues from 2012, 2013 and 2014 (as yet unbound) are archived on the website and available to view on a computer. These Hearsay pages are a fascinating chronicle of four decades of civic activities and an insight into the character of our smart, eccentric, conservation-minded and community-oriented town of Bolinas. # Hearsay News Recipe 40th-year Lemon Curd Cookies

(These cookies will be served at the Hearsay News/Bolinas Museum party celebrating the first 40 years of the Hearsay News on Saturday, November 15, starting at 2:00 in the Courtyard. They won't last long, and neither will you if you eat too many. You might want to bring milk.)

- 1 box yellow cake mix
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 2 sticks butter

combine sugar and cake mix - melt butter until liquid - mix with sugar and cake into a thick batter - fashion five or six thumb-sized 10" rolls of dough - cut into 1/2 " pieces and place at 1" intervals on two 9 x 12 greased cookie sheets - bake in 350<sup>a</sup> oven until golden brown - Set on rack to cool.

**Separately assemble**

- 1 (14oz) can sweetened condensed milk,
- 6 - 8 egg yolks - 1 can's worth of lemon juice

whisk condensed milk and egg yolks in a saucepan over low heat - add lemon juice, and whisk until it thickens - Set aside to cool

Pipe lemon curd onto cookies -Dust with powdered sugar - Eat

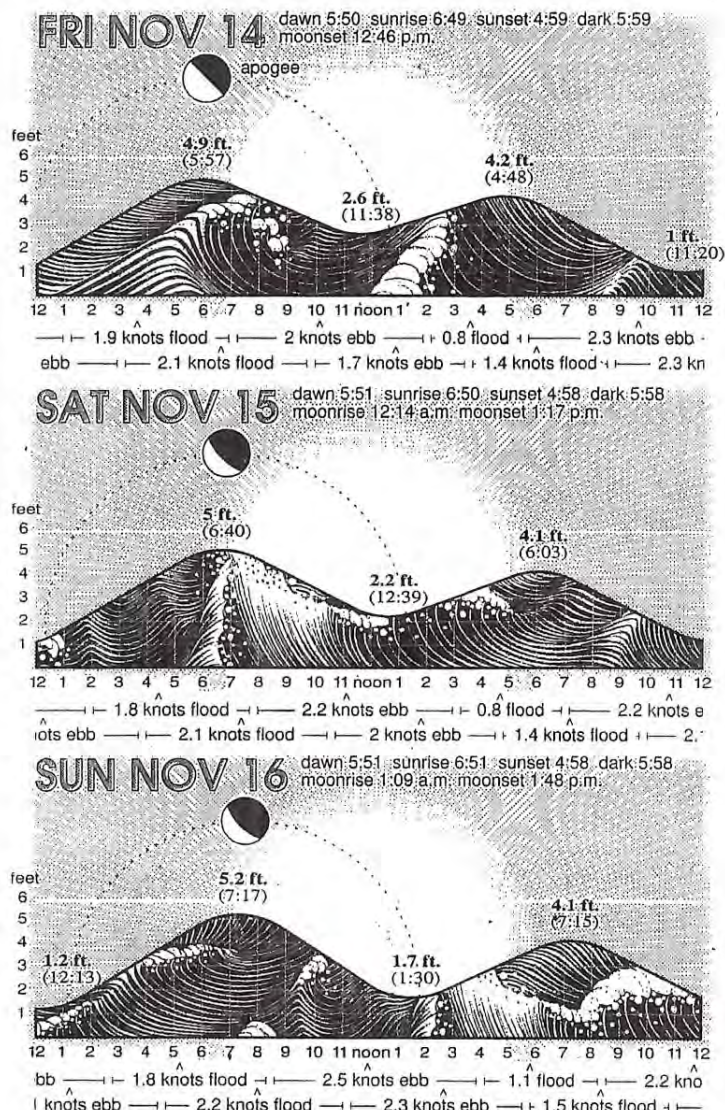
