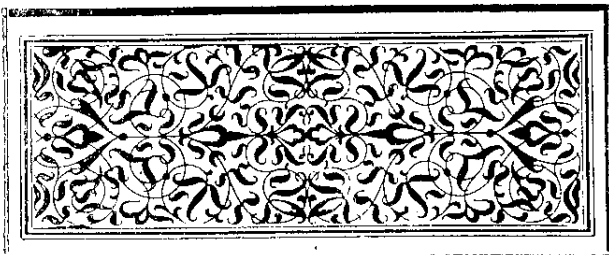

Do you want dinner too? Well, that is what restaurants are for!

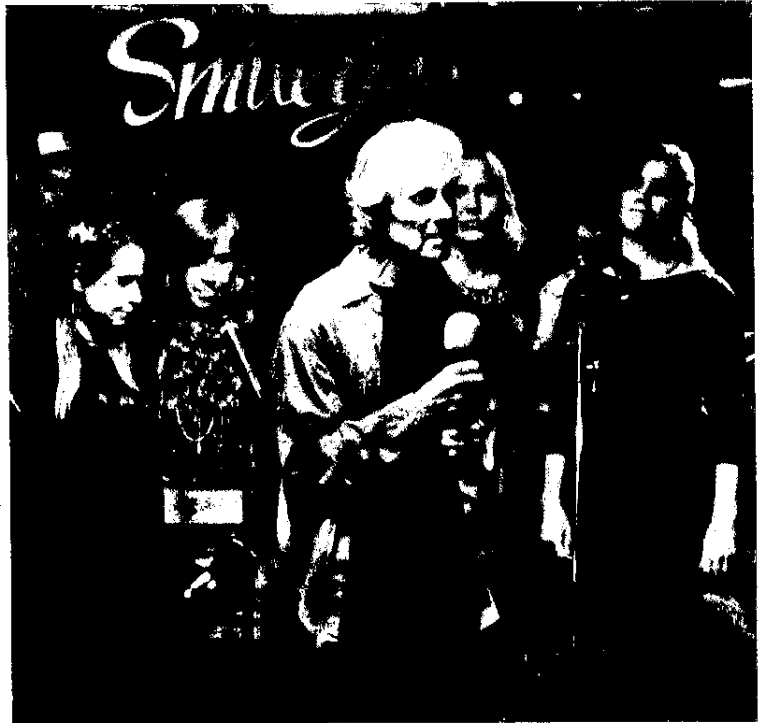
