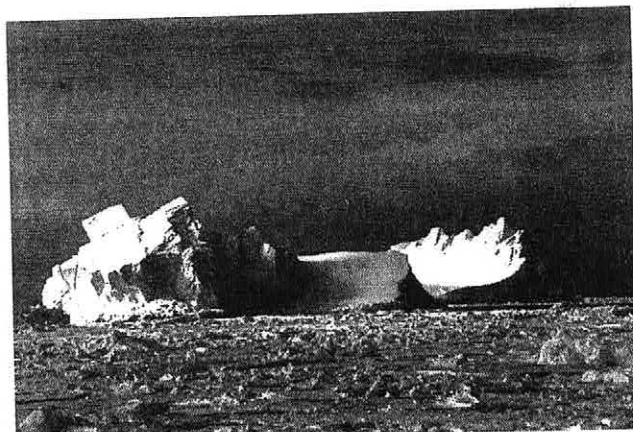

**Classic Music Series Returns**

As the fall weather emerges, an opportunity to hear the classics as another way to renew the returning season. The next four Saturday evenings, St Magdalene's Church will be filled with music – 7 p.m. – starting with Molly Maguire's production of Gabriel Faure's celestial Requiem. The classic 19<sup>th</sup> century wooden building provides beautiful acoustics, especially for singers.

The next concert (the 11<sup>th</sup> – honoring Vets) contrasts the two titans of the classical era: Papa Haydn and his junior genius, Mozart. Two boisterous sonatas will bookend two reflective pieces of great beauty with classic and adventurous harmony. In the brilliant allegro movements, come hear the roots of rock 'n roll!

The concert on the 18<sup>th</sup>, Molly Maguire's choir will return to present Vivaldi and Faure with a smaller group of singers. Another treat will be the opportunity to hear Colleen Hick's spiritual choir in residence at St. Magdalene's. The pianist will continue the theme of contrasting Baroque music with 20<sup>th</sup> century repertoire. Highlights will certainly be hearing Molly's rarely heard sweet soprano sound in her classical side.

Thanksgiving weekend brings a program of French Impressionism and its influence on other composers. Debussy and Ravel will be well represented along with other gems.

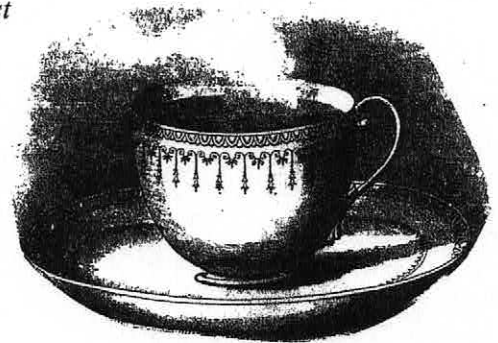
Another aspect of this concert series is that the music is heard on the 21<sup>st</sup> century keyboard, in lieu of piano (as there are no public grand pianos available in Bobo). The keyboard offers a new way to hear familiar classics with possibilities of various sustaining sounds instead of the percussive hammerklavier.

Molly's beautifully produced event will be a classic concert; where as the rest of the Café Concert series will be more of an intimate affair, sitting close around the keyboard.

I would like to thank the Bolinas-Stinson Community Fund for their generous support of this ongoing music series. It made a huge difference in being able to continue this series and to bring other artists to town.

Donations are \$1.00 – 100.00, so really, all are welcome. Come hear the leading sounds of past epochs, and the emotions they still produce.
