To Bolinas Residents:

I am truly sad to see the signs enquiring on the whereabouts of a missing cat (an 11lb orange tabby) in the Poplar/Dogwood neighborhood. As a fellow cat owner I know well the anxiety of losing a close pet.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind all cat owners that with the recent re-population of coyotes in West Marin, domestic cats are at high risk when allowed to roam free. Injury and disease are also more prevalent with outdoor cats.

Not only are they at risk, but they can also pose a problem for the numerous ground feeding sparrows and towhees that winter in Bolinas. Yes, even well fed cats like to hunt. Some of my favorite birds, the Golden-crowned Sparrows, have recently returned from the far north. (Listen for the 'oh dear me' song all over the Mesa) It is important that we provide safe habitat in the winter to ensure that these Golden-crowns can return to the breeding grounds in Alaska next spring.

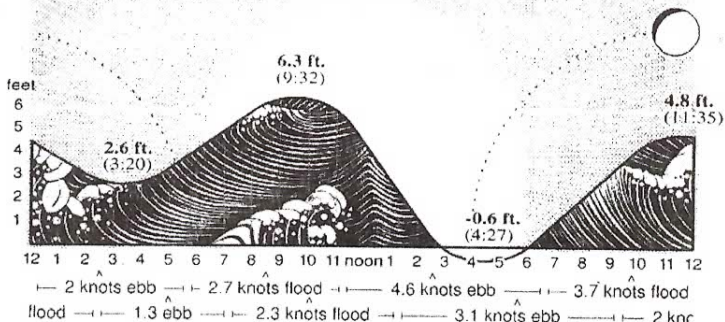
Geminid Meteor Shower

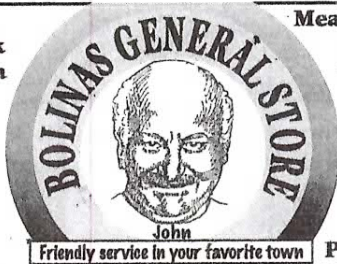

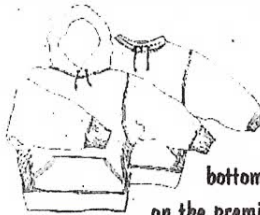
