### 611 miles in 57 days: Not bad for a Monarch butterfly

YAKIMA, Wash. -- Since fluttering out of downtown Yakima in September with 89 others, the Monarch butterfly known as C1775 has traveled 611 miles in less than two months. The butterfly was found in Bolinas, Calif. — in the San Francisco Bay area — on Nov. 18 as part of the annual Western Monarch Thanksgiving Count in California.

Bolinas is 611 miles south/southwest of Yakima, noted David James, Washington State University associate professor of entomology.

“This (release and tracking) has been done for more than two decades and gives us an idea of population trends,” said James, who tracks Monarch migration patterns and released the cage of 90 butterflies that included C1775 on Sept. 22 as part of an ongoing study.

C1775 is the only Monarch recovered from the 90 released on Sept. 22. Five other Yakima-released Monarchs recovered in California so far this year were released at other times and ended up in Santa Cruz, James said. The straight-line distance between Yakima and Santa Cruz is 674 miles, he said.

“It is remarkable that five of the six were found in the same town in California,” James said in an email. “In fact, four of the five were found at the same overwintering sites on the same trees.

“So they independently traveled more than 600 miles (likely taking different routes) but ended up at the same spot,” he noted.

The tagging program has yielded “quite a lot” of data on migration from the Pacific Northwest to California since it began in 2012, James said. But there are still unanswered questions, such as how and why monarchs from one location manage to travel more than 600 miles and end up on the same tree.

“We don’t know how they do this at all,” James wrote.

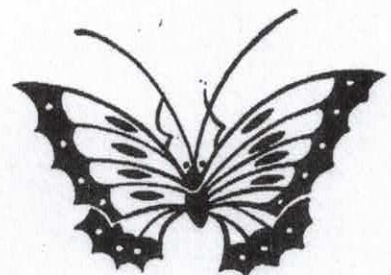

Our friend James McDaniel was arrested in Iquitos, Peru, several days ago in a police raid on his hotel room. He is currently being held in police custody and accused of possession of 4 kilos of marijuana, which is a serious offence in Peru and he could face up to 8 years in jail.

The next 10 days are going to be absolutely crucial and he needs the help of a very good lawyer to stand any chance of successfully fighting these charges and securing his release.

"One day we hope we will be able to microchip monarchs so we could follow the migration of individuals day by day."

That could provide much more detailed information about migration patterns, overwintering sites and migration mortality rates for Monarchs, some of which are killed by cars.

Those who raise, tag and follow the monarchs have found "maybe a dozen" in Bolinas since 2012 and about three times that many in Santa Cruz, James said. Santa Cruz is on the northern end of Monterey Bay.

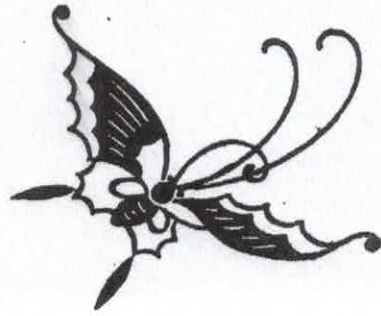
"What determines whether they go to Santa Cruz or Bolinas? We don't know. Perhaps it's something to do with prevailing weather/wind conditions during migration," he said.

"It was interesting this year to learn that the extremely smoky conditions we had when Monarchs were beginning their migration didn't seem to affect their ability to survive and navigate."

Sadly, C1775 won't see Yakima again.

"There is still time for more Yakima monarchs to be found in California. They continue overwintering there until the end of February. At this time they begin to fly north again," James said. "However, they only make it as far as Northern California, laying eggs on milkweed for the next generation.

"It is the next two generations of butterflies that continue flying north (and) end up in Washington. So it's the children and grandchildren of our September 2017 monarchs that come back to Yakima in summer 2018," James said.
