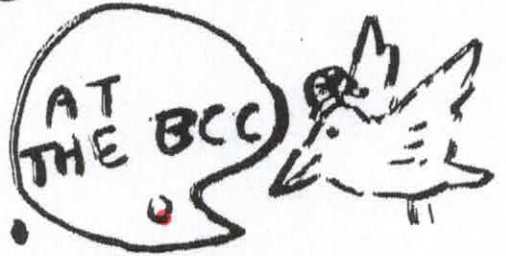

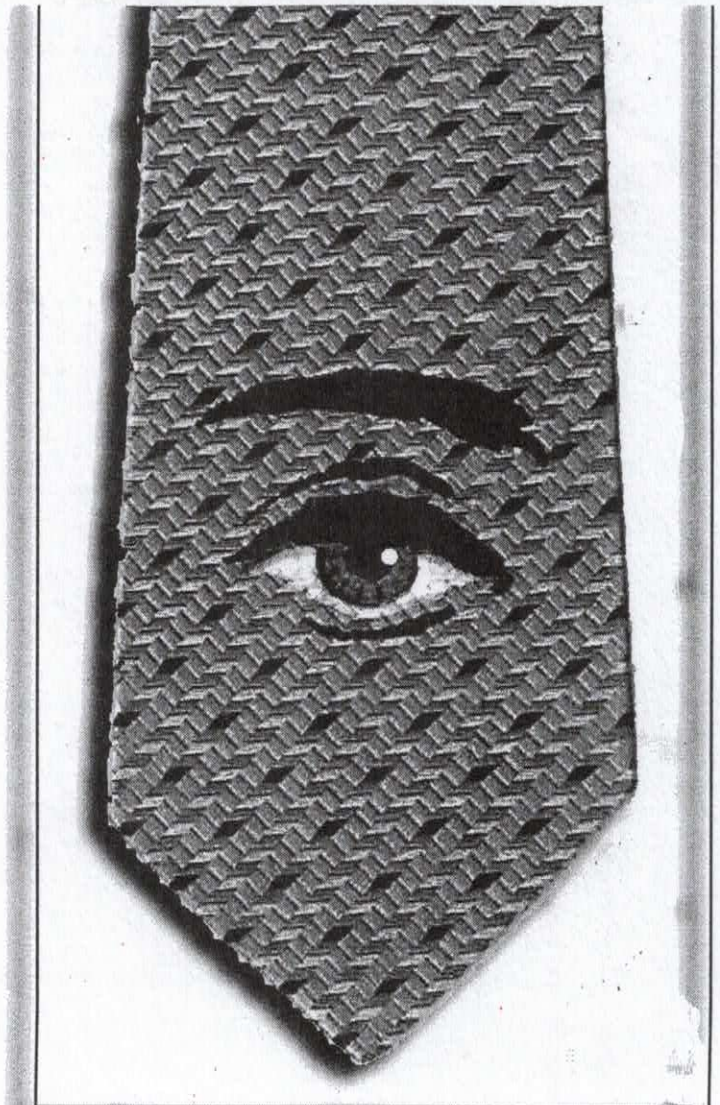

Open Letter to the Bolinas Stinson Union School  
District & Superintendent John Carroll

I would like to add my 2 cents to the prospect of a new bond measure on next fall's ballot for improving school facilities before it's too late.

I believe that the real reason the last one lost was because the \$ 9 million ask was so big, & the 1 year annual increase in property taxes would be so big, that it scared a faithful sector of voters like me who always support schools, because it could threaten their ability to keep their homes; & that is senior home owners with limited incomes. As a group we are consistent yes voters yet I heard a lot of angry unsolicited opinions, & a lot of fear.

No one votes against schools. That would be nuts, but property taxes go up about \$100 a year, thus \$1,000 per decade, in my case over \$2,000 in the 17 years I've owned my house. This last bond would have meant a \$400 increase in just 1 year Including all the other random ones, & being a bond there would be no exemptions for seniors as there is with a parcel tax.

As we age & retire income decreases as expenses increase. This accidentally pits the old against the young, a problem that is no one's fault but is a fact.

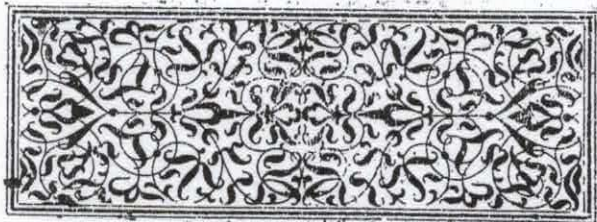
Tam High School District is considering a parcel tax ballot measure for next year to compound the problem.

Many of us rent to residents to make ends meet. Every house sold is probably 1 less rental, so that's no good for the town either.

John Carroll said in an article in the Light that the school is in good financial shape, better than most, so with great respect for the hardworking teachers, staff, & board members of our school, I'm asking for due consideration on the affect this bond could have on a fragile portion of our population, probably none of whom were asked to fill out the 4 question survey & appear to be forgotten in these plans.

**Birds & Their Nests:**

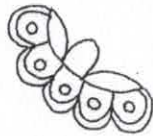
**A Conversation with Keith Hansen**
