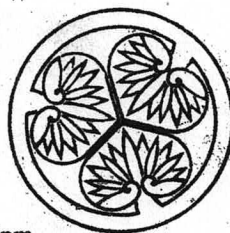

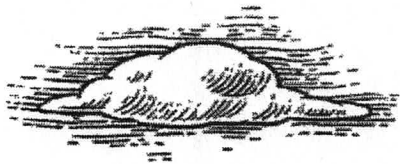

LAST TWO WEEKENDS!

Art / Astronomy
at Bolinas Museum!

Don't miss seeing the remarkable exhibitions at Bolinas Museum before they end on December 30. Art and astronomy meld in *Cosmic Wonders* with images of the moon that include a NASA photo of the first time human eyes saw the earth rise over the moon's surface, and glass plate negatives from 1893. Expressions of wonder come from contemporary photographers and artists Linda Connor, Russell Crotty, Don Jolley, Amelia Konow, Marty Knapp, Michael Light and Charles Lindsey. The historic instruments, journals, and glass plate negatives are from the Lick Observatory in San Jose, which has the distinction of being the first mountain-top-continually-inhabited (by scientists) observatory in the world! Einstein depended on data from this observatory before he could present his General Theory of Relativity. Then from looking at stars, Joel Coen invites you inward for a very personal experience. He makes movies for hundreds to view at a time, but his own creations are Zen-like stereoscope boxes for intimate, individual viewing. In the Permanent Collection gallery, see Mardi Wood's Saturn Bowl, a Marty Knapp image, and paintings by Christin Coy, Susan Hall, Charles Eckhart, Waldemar Matrowski, Charles Dumont Otis and the dramatic Thaddeaus Welch painting of the luminous evening hills on the East side of Bolinas Lagoon, long before there was a road from Bolinas to Stinson Beach. Also see the history room exhibit about the Parkin family who had the Flagstaff Inn, the big hotel that stood as the edge of the lagoon from 1862 to the 1906 earthquake, with images of surfing at Bolinas in 1909, and pioneering wireless communication.

Bolinas Museum will reopen with new exhibitions on January 12, 2019. Admission to the exhibitions is always free.
