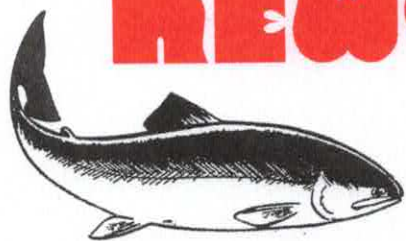

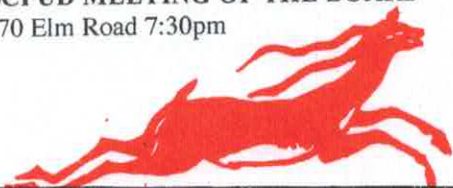

West Marin Standing Together

About fifty people attended the meeting of WMST at the Dance Palace March 4th. This was the third meeting of the group which formally adopted this new name on Saturday. Facilitators Bing Gong and Cornelia Durrant skillfully kept us to a precise schedule as we moved through the agenda.

David Morris, co-founder of The Institute for Local Self-Reliance gave an interesting talk with insights into the Trump administration. Mary Morgan told us about the work Indivisible West Marin is doing. Tim Weed and The Common Voice Choir sang a couple of inspiring songs.

We talked about doing a fund Woolsey and it was suggested that we might show the film "Demain". The idea is to do a Community "Teach In" to raise awareness and money.

The various committees reported about their plans and two new committees were proposed: 1) Healthcare & 2) Youth Engagement.

A tutorial on "Same Page" was given so that we might communicate with each other more efficiently. If you would like to join the Same Page group you will be able to closely follow the activities of WMST as it develops.

During the report on recommended organizational alliances a request was made for volunteers to liason with other activist groups. Bing Gong reported on collaborating with United Marin Rising & Marin Coalition Leaders.
