Dear Bolinas Neighbors:

Many of you have noticed the spot just above the Olema-Bolinas Road, between #655 and #455 over the Lagoon, where a dense former grove of blue gum eucalyptus is now lying on the hillside as if Zeus got bored with a game of pick-up sticks, or perhaps his day job as a clear-cutter in Oregon. Understandably, many of you are wondering what the Jove is going on.

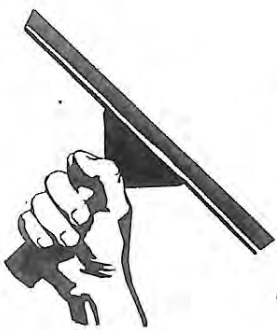
Please be assured that our ultimate goal is full restoration of the native California oak forest on the hillside, and we are committed to seeing it through over time. Right now the hillside is particularly unsightly, and we ask for your aesthetic patience amidst this work-in-progress: over the next couple of months the hillside will be cleared of the deadfall and native replanting will begin. Some work via the road will need to happen, resulting in some lane-closure inconvenience, for which we apologize in advance. The root system of the former grove has deliberately been left intact to prevent erosion while the new natives emerge, and stumps will be kept free of shoots.

The Bolinas Lagoon Restoration Plan advocates for general long-term removal of eucalyptus along the Olema-Bolinas Road; Marin County is working steadily to eliminate eucs for reasons of deadfall and road safety (see current work on Nicasio Valley Road at the junction of Lucas Valley Road); euc groves are a tremendous fire hazard (see our own 3.5-acre fire north of Agate Beach this last May 10); and biologically blue gum eucalyptus are extraordinarily destructive, working to shut out all other plant life.

Called "America's largest weed" by some, we realize that others in the community treasure the blue gum eucalyptus. They are indeed majestic in height, but as concerned stewards of our adjacent parcels, we are opting for the path of native restoration, at no cost to the public purse, and ask for your understanding.

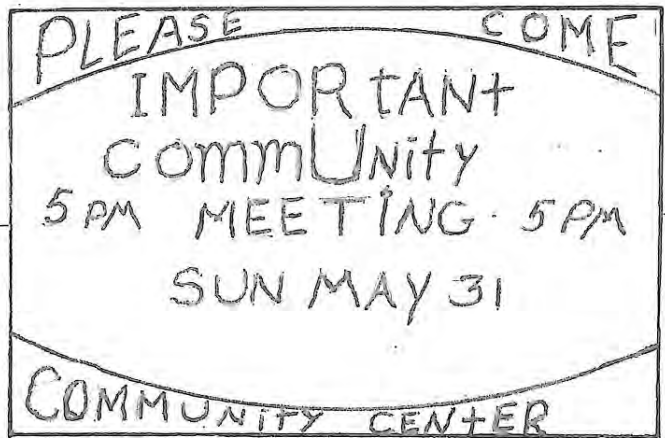

The most pressing issue right now in Bolinas is the lack of housing. We are literally being bought up. At least 50% of the houses in Bolinas are second homes and too many are empty most of the time. What is available is getting more and more expensive or turned into short-term rentals.

To this end we have called for a town meeting. The Bolinas Community Land Trust has been the leader in housing and has been looking into this particular issue for a long time. They have come up with some very creative and inspiring ways to house people. They will be giving a report on the work they have been doing.

BoCan, who is calling this meeting, is a new group of younger people, many who grew up here, are going to present themselves and the work they are doing. If there is time and interest we will deal with other issues that are affecting Bolinas. So, as the sign says, "Please Come!"

I want to be clear about something. Many of the second homeowners in Bolinas are truly a part of our community. Their hearts are here and they show it. I also know that offering short-term rentals provide some of us with a way to be here. Everyone has his or her own way of making it work. We are a community and we know who we are. I'm not pointing fingers. I am speaking my truth. I just want us to come together as a community and begin to create another story.

We are the town that fought to save itself and damn if we don't have to do it again. We've done it before. Let's talk.
