If you would like to run for one of these seats in the November 3, 2015 election, you must declare your candidacy during the filing period, which opens **July 13, 2015** and closes **August 7, 2015 at 5:00 p.m.** The appropriate forms are available from the Registrar of Voters office at the Civic Center (Room 121) and must be filed there. If either of the two BCPUD Directors whose terms expire at the end of November decide that they do not want to run for another 4-year term, the filing period for **non-incumbents only** will be extended through **August 12, 2015.**

Alison wrote to us:

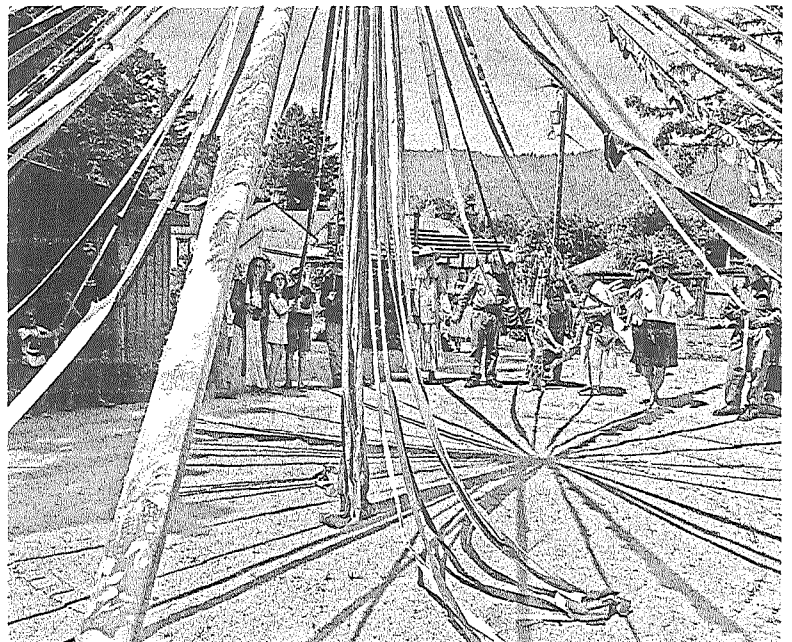
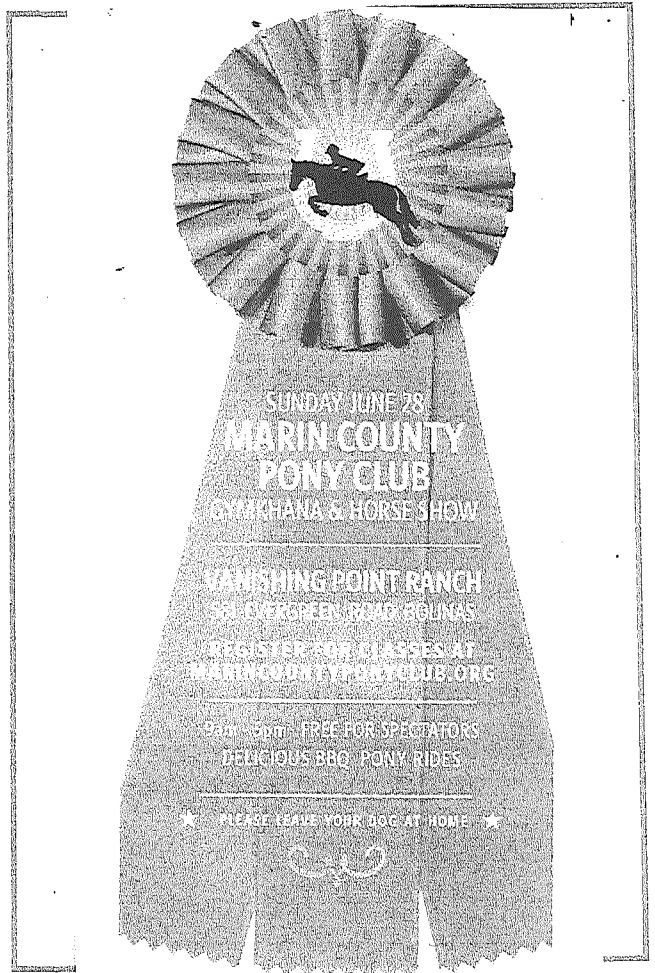
I am a former West Marin resident with longtime ties to the area. I have a deep connection to Point Reyes and the Dance Palace.
