Celebrating life is really what it's about. Welcoming the new ones to Bolinas and honoring the renewal of community.

I've never stopped calling it "Floating Sun." Pierrot gave it that name at the beginning. To me Floating Sun honors a Balinese influence, one might call it Bolinese, that is manifested in parasols, flowers and brightly colored streamers. Floating Sun used to be Bolinas's May Day or Beltane. We were younger then, and bacchanal celebrations were easier to handle.

Now Sun Festival is about the baby blessing, welcoming the new radiant incarnations to our town. Tom will cradle each babies in his majestic hands, then raise the baby high.

"Welcome, \_\_\_\_!" we'll greet each starchild, each new Bolinisian with their name. It's a fabulous opportunity to witness the growth of our community firsthand.
"Welcome beautiful babies!"

Four Daikinis will dance as I intone "Bo Om." The Daikinis will wave Bo Om placards in the air, keeping time and signalling to the assembly when to sing "Bo Om." "Bo Om" simply means the Universal Vibration

"Bo Om" simply means the Universal Vibration sympathetically vibrated in Bolinas. Last year as I was singing "Bo Om" and the Daikinis were dancing I looked skyward. The wispy, high cirrus clouds were deliciously softening the Sun's fiery energy and I saw raybeams of light falling down on the Festival.

"Maybe I'll see an angel." I thought as I tried to make out wings or other angelic things amongst the clouds. But I quickly realized that a true Sun Festival vision was bigger than anything I could imagine. There was a connectedness between the watery blue orb of Earth and the fiery energy of the Sun that was beyond my comprehension. It was too majestic, and too mundane.

Sun Festival is a celebration of the marriage of Sun and Earth. If you think about it, everything is a Sun Festival on this Planet. Sun Festival is a wedding party, and the babies are already born. We're all children at play in the Fields of Bo, let's celebrate and appreciate it.






