Come celebrate summer and the opening of three new exhibitions; *In Parallel: Windy Chien & Serena Mitnik-Miller, Meghann Riepenhoff: Nearshore, and Jan Langdon: Loomed.* Inspiring talks with the artists and curators at 4 pm will be followed by the opening for the community!

Enjoy live music in the courtyard by Sandy's. The band is known for their groovy surf sounds inspired by life along the coast. On their new EP, "Chime," San Francisco surf rock quintet Sandy's sound like Big Star in Big Sur. Glassy open tunings are buoyed by bouncing drum fills and soaked in resonant moog flourishes. This event is partially supported by the Stinson-Bolinas Community Fund. Refreshment provided by Lagunitas and HenHouse Brewing Companies while it lasts.

**The new exhibitions:** In the main gallery, San Francisco creatives **Windy Chien** and **Serena Mitnik-Miller** use different mediums to revel in the power and potential of a simple line. Mitnik-Miller's geometric watercolors begin with cues from nature, then multiply into interlocking patterns of pigment. Chien uses rope and knots to create her elegant forms, often on a large scale; the exhibition features works inspired by her effort to learn a new knot every day for a year. In the photography gallery, **Meghann Riepenhoff's** cyanotypes are created in collaboration with the elusive forces of nature: wind, waves, tides, rain and light. Her exhibition includes works that correlate with Bolinas tides. A 2018-2019 Guggenheim Fellow, Riepenhoff is based in Bainbridge Island and San Francisco. In the Coastal Marin Artists Gallery, works by weaver **Jan Langdon** who used fiber like a painter, layering geometric forms, vibrant colors and diverse textures. Despite declining health, Langdon enthusiastically helped plan this exhibition before she died in April. She was an active member of the Bay Area fiber and Coast Marin communities and this exhibition celebrates her creative spirit.

The museum is open at noon. Please not **Please note**, the gallery talks and party are scheduled for late afternoon, with the hope that there will be more parking for locals by then. Everyone is welcome!

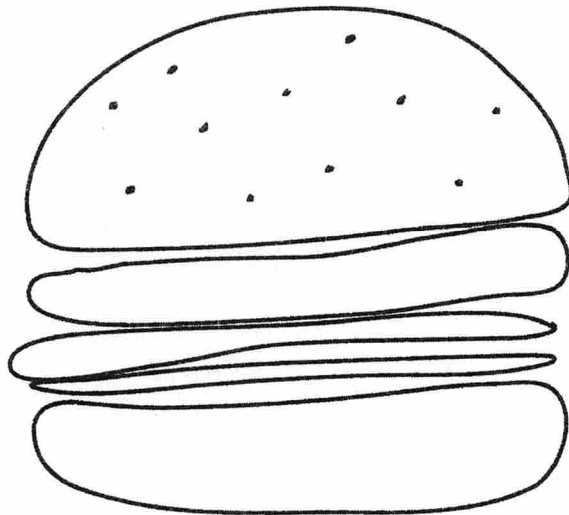

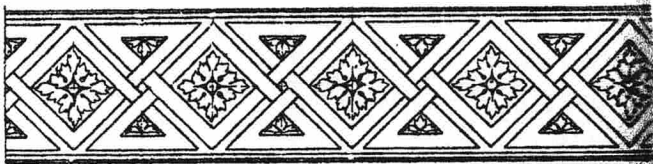

### JUNE 22 BOLINAS JAZZ CAFE STARS MULTIPLE GRAMMY WINNER

The appearance of Paul McCandless at the June 22 Community Center Jazz Cafe is, for Bolinas, both an honor and a reunion.

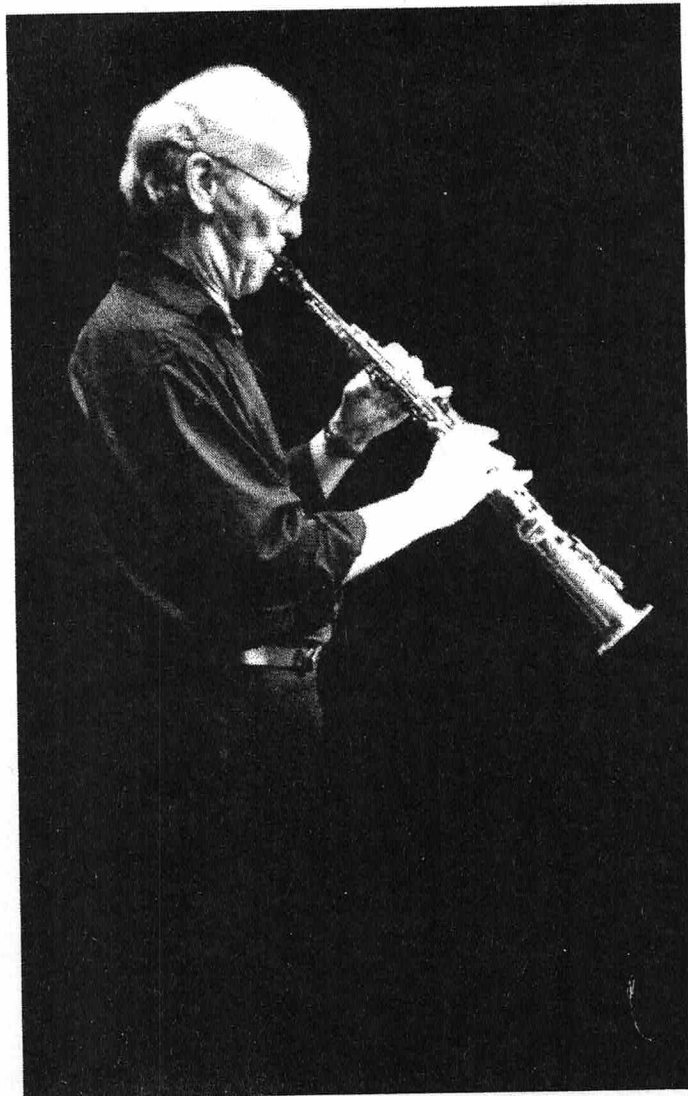
Paul--who is a multiple Grammy winner and plays most of the woodwind family--lived here for several years in the eighties. His friends here remember him as a gracious and unassuming presence, gladly taking part in the life of the town. His then wife, Robin, taught dance classes at the Community Center.

It is somewhat daunting to try to list Paul's awards and achievements--with his own band, Oregon, and touring and recording with many other groups. Here are some of the Grammys he has won: Best Pop Instrumental Performance with Béla Fleck and the Flecktones, two Grammys for Best New Age Album with the Paul Winter Consort; and nominations for Best Instrumental Composition and Best Arrangement for his piece "Round Robin" in the "Oregon In Moscow" album, and for Best Jazz Instrumental Solo in the album "1000 Kilometers".

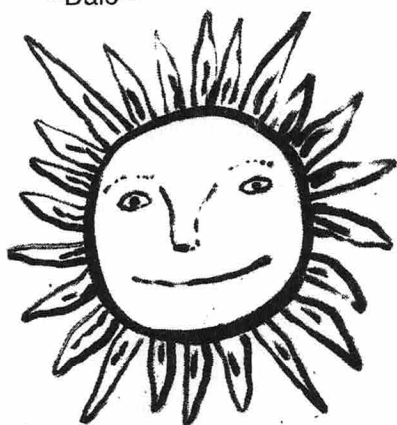
As a soloist, he has appeared with major symphony orchestras, including the Los Angeles Philharmonic and the Philadelphia Orchestra.

At the Jazz Cafe, Paul will be joined by local stars Piro Patton on bass and Michael Pinkham on drums, with well known Bay Area jazzmaster Si Perkoff on keyboard. Opening the night will be the Dale Polissar Trio, with Dale's clarinet joined by Si and Piro.
