West Marin's increasingly tourist-dependent economy has been responsible for the conversion of long-term rentals into AirB&B-type overnight accommodations, dramatically worsening an affordable housing crisis in our communities. The same visitor influx that has taken so many homes off the long-term rental market has also severely strained the capabilities of the emergency responders in the area, usually volunteer fire departments. Simultaneously, this lack of affordable housing has reduced the number of recruits available for West Marin's volunteer fire departments.

The ballot measure known as TOT2 addresses these twin crises by increasing the Transient Occupancy Tax, a hotel tax charged to visitors for stays of less than 30 days and collected by the owners of those accommodations. The present TOT rate will be increased from 10% to 15% in West Marin communities. The additional 5% will be retained locally and used for the creation and support of community housing (\$740,000/year) and for the expansion of our first responder capabilities, including recruiting, staffing and equipping our fire houses (\$740,000/year). None of this increase goes into the Marin County General Fund. All of the increase remains in West Marin to be used exclusively for emergency responder support and support and creation of community housing. Disbursements will be under local control.


- No tax increase for West Marin residents.
- Funding in perpetuity for support of our beleaguered first responders
- Funding in perpetuity for community housing opportunities in West Marin.
- Local control of all expenditures.

Supervisor Dennis Rodoni, every Fire Chief and all of the community housing advocates in West Marin support this ballot measure. Come to the meeting and voice your support to the Supervisors to ensure that this measure will appear on the November ballot.

**2018 ELECTION NEWS! DEADLINES FOR  
CANDIDACY AND FOR BALLOT  
MEASURES! PLEASE READ!**

The terms of three (3) BCPUD Directors expire this year. If you would like to run for one of these seats in the November 6, 2018 election, you must declare your candidacy during the filing period, which opens **July 16, 2018** and closes **August 10, 2018**. The appropriate forms are available from the Registrar of Voters office at the Civic Center (Room 121) and must be filed there. If any of the three BCPUD Directors whose terms are expiring at the end of November decide that they do not want to run for another 4-year term, the filing period for **non-incumbents only** will be extended by several days (the specific date is not yet available).

The last day to submit measures for placement on the November ballot is **August 10, 2018**; the last day to withdraw a measure from the ballot is **August 15, 2018**. The last day to submit ballot arguments is **August 20, 2018** and the last day to submit rebuttal arguments is **August 27, 2018**. In each case, the pertinent documents must be received by the County's Election Office by **4:30 p.m.** on the deadline date.

It is an exuberant celebration of summer, Zen, and feminine energy. Mayumi Oda's playful large format silkscreen prints present wisdom and compassion expressed as voluptuous goddesses and vibrant vegetables that express the bounty of earth. This body of Oda's work began in the 1970s when she settled in Muir Beach. While walking through the lush dawn-lit farm fields on her way to morning meditation at the young Green Gulch Zen center, the simple beauty around her inspired Oda's art for the next forty years. Her work is reproduced in many publications and collected internationally.

Distinguished Marin photographer Linda Connor brings us powerful images from Ladakh, India, high in the Himalayas where the tops of mountains were once seafloor and the starkly beautiful landscape contrasts with the richly detailed Buddhist culture. Connor has been influential in the Bay Area photography scene since the 1960s. She still teaches at San Francisco Art Institute and founded PhotoAlliance. Bolinas potter Patricia Yenawine's handsome clay vessels are the result of a collaboration between her skill and aesthetic and the an *anagame* wood-firing kiln where fire and smoke create patterns and color on the clay. In her artist statement Yenawine describes the challenges and unpredictability of working with clay, glazes, kilns and fire, yet she savors the surprises. Yenawine settled in Bolinas in 1991 after working at the Metropolitan Museum Education Department in New York, dancing and acting in Chicago, and farming in the Hudson Valley.
