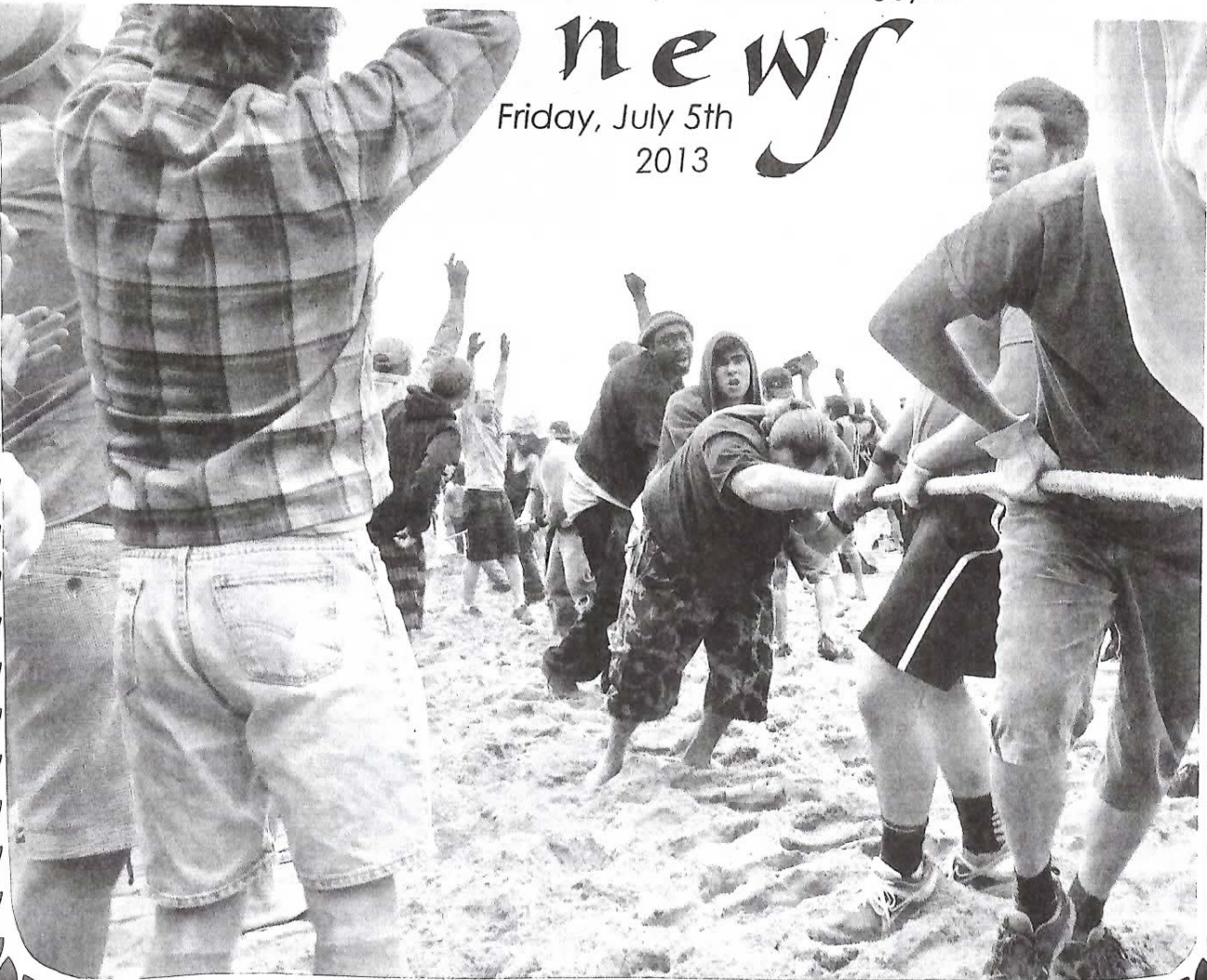

UPDATED ELECTION NEWS!

**DEADLINES FOR CANDIDACY AND FOR
BALLOT MEASURES! PLEASE READ!**

The terms of 3 BCPUD Directors expire this year.** If you would like to run for one of these seats in the November 5, 2013 election, you must declare your candidacy during the filing period, which opens **July 15, 2013** and closes **August 9, 2013 at 5:00 p.m.** The appropriate forms are available from the Registrar of Voters office at the Civic Center (Room 121) and must be filed there. If any of the 3 BCPUD Directors whose terms are expiring at the end of November decide that they do not want to run for another 4-year term, the filing period for **non-incumbents only** will be extended through **August 14, 2013.**

**** UPDATE ON BCPUD INCUMBENT DIRECTORS:** one of the three incumbent BCPUD Directors whose terms expire this year has publicly declared his intention to run for reelection and two of the three incumbent BCPUD Directors whose terms expire this year have publicly declared their intentions *not* to run for reelection.

The last day to submit measures for placement on the November ballot is **August 9, 2013**; the last day to withdraw a measure from the ballot is **August 14, 2013.** The last day to submit ballot arguments is **August 19, 2013** and the last day to submit rebuttal arguments is **August 26, 2013.** In each case, the pertinent documents regarding measures on the ballot must be received by the County's Election Office by **4:30 p.m.** on the deadline date.

Now Get Ready For A Major Abridgment Of Your Right To Vote

The Marin County Grand Jury Has Decided that very soon we will all be voting only by mail. No kidding. Read today's editorial in the IJ.

Absentee ballots are not necessarily counted on election day at all. This could really skew results, especially in a state like ours, which is the only one that can balance out a state like Texas. The next step will be the entire state. Oregon conducts all of it's elections this way already.

This is of course ostensibly, and very logically, a way to save money, \$100 to \$200,000 per election, a pretty penny to be sure but a pittance compared to our basic democratic right to vote. The county is wasting that much on the special election to recall Supervisor Susan Adams.

Call me paranoid but I smell a rat named ALEC, or The American Legislative Exchange Council, or one of their little friends. Google them if you have not been warned yet by Bill Moyers (the only man on TV who tells the truth).

These people don't want you to vote at all. Why stop at curtailing voting rights for minorities like the Supreme Court just did. They don't want anyone to vote who isn't just like them.

Do I sound upset? I am. Join me in a move to stop this now. There may be just enough outrage left in West Marin but I'm not sure about the rest of us.
