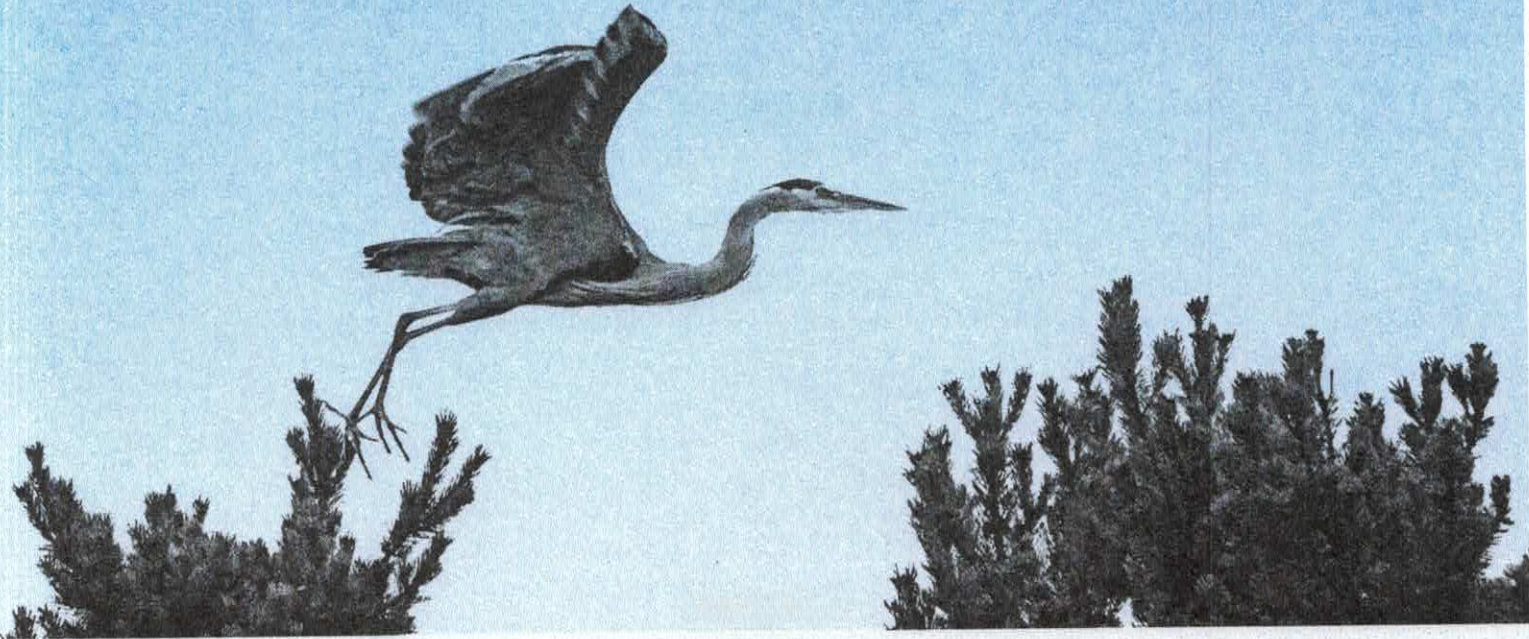

After months of public discussion and consultations with County staff, at a special meeting on August 8, 2018, the BCPUD Board of Directors voted to place an advisory measure on the ballot for the November 2018 election concerning a County of Marin proposal to regulate overnight parking in downtown Bolinas. The Advisory Measure reads as follows:

"Shall the County of Marin enact a resolution pursuant to Marin County Ordinance 3662 to include Brighton Avenue, Park Avenue and Wharf Road in downtown Bolinas as County roads on which there shall be no overnight parking of vehicles, except for automobiles, motorcycles and pickups, between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.?"

BCPUD staff submitted the advisory ballot measure language to the County Elections Department prior to the August 10, 2018 deadline. There will now be a ten (10) day "public examination period of measures" from August 11, 2018 through August 20, 2018. On August 13, 2018, the Registrar of Voters will assign a measure letter to the Bolinas advisory ballot measure. **August 20, 2018** is the last day to submit a ballot argument (300 word limit) to the Elections Department after which there is another public examination period from August 21, 2018 through August 30, 2018. **August 27, 2018** is the last day to submit rebuttals for or against a measure.

The BCPUD Board of Directors will discuss these deadlines and other requirements for ballot arguments and rebuttals at its regular meeting on August 15, 2018.

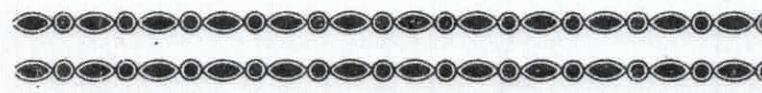


Correction

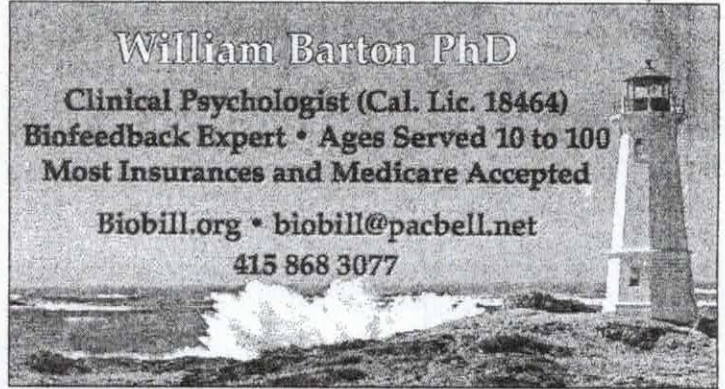

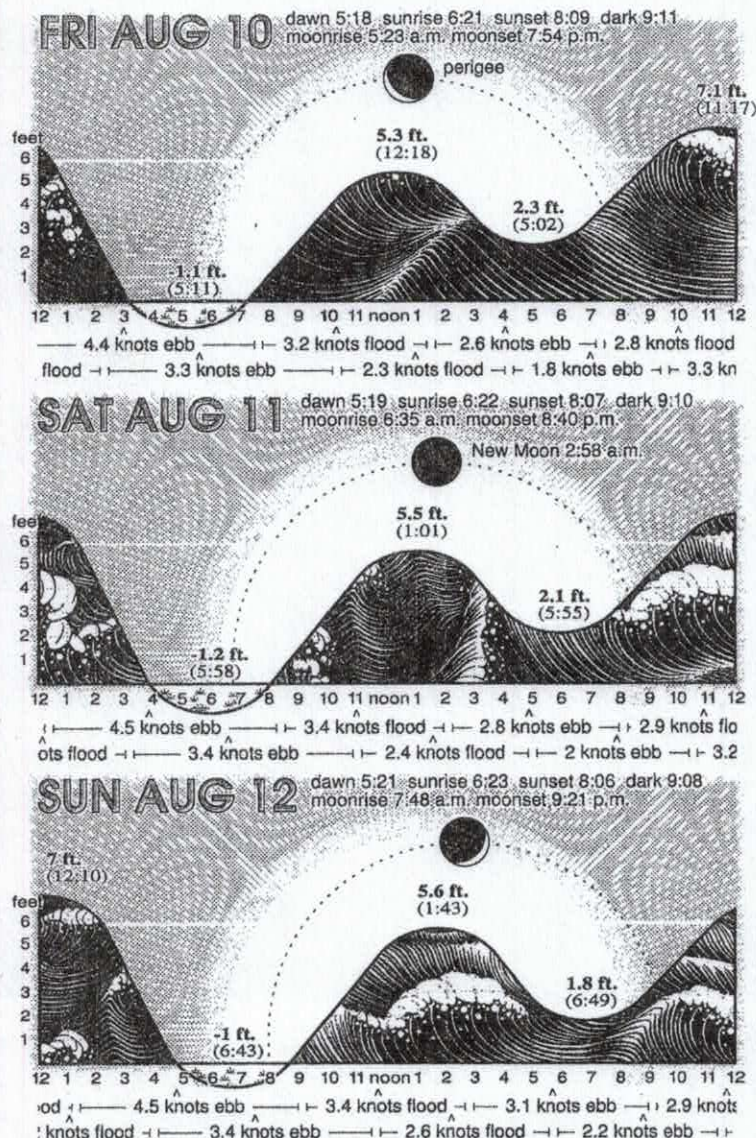


