Cream of Miso Soup

Chop lots of vegetables into soup size bits.

This is very good with onions, leeks, garlic, shredded cabbage, potatoes, summer squash, and please try peeled chunks of butternut squash.

2 T grated fresh ginger

cover with water in a soup pot, leaving room for more broth...[it's hard to make just a little bit of this soup]

simmer til done

in a measuring cup or small bowl, blend

½ cup of miso paste with

½ c of plain soymilk

add 1 litre of soymilk to the pot of vegetables, heat well but do not boil

turn off heat

add miso paste mixture to the pot, stir well add salt and pepper to taste

* do not boil this soup when you are reheating it for another meal, just warm it gently. Soymilk may curdle. Miso is alive.
