

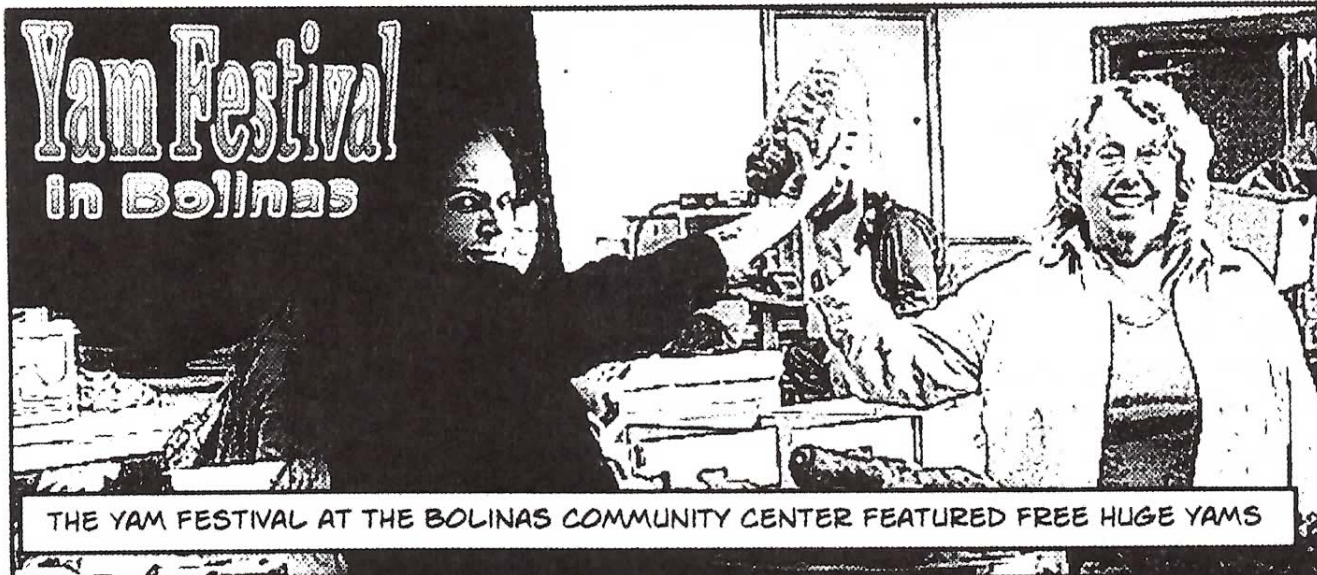

**Apple Pressing at Blackberry Farm
Saturday, September 28th, beginning at 10am.**

The apple pressing usually lasts into the afternoon, depending on how many people show up and how many apples you bring. You can start harvesting apples for pressing about a week before – the longer they sit the more they sweat and sweeten. Expect a bushel (45-50 lbs) of fruit to give you 2 – 3 gallons of fresh juice.
