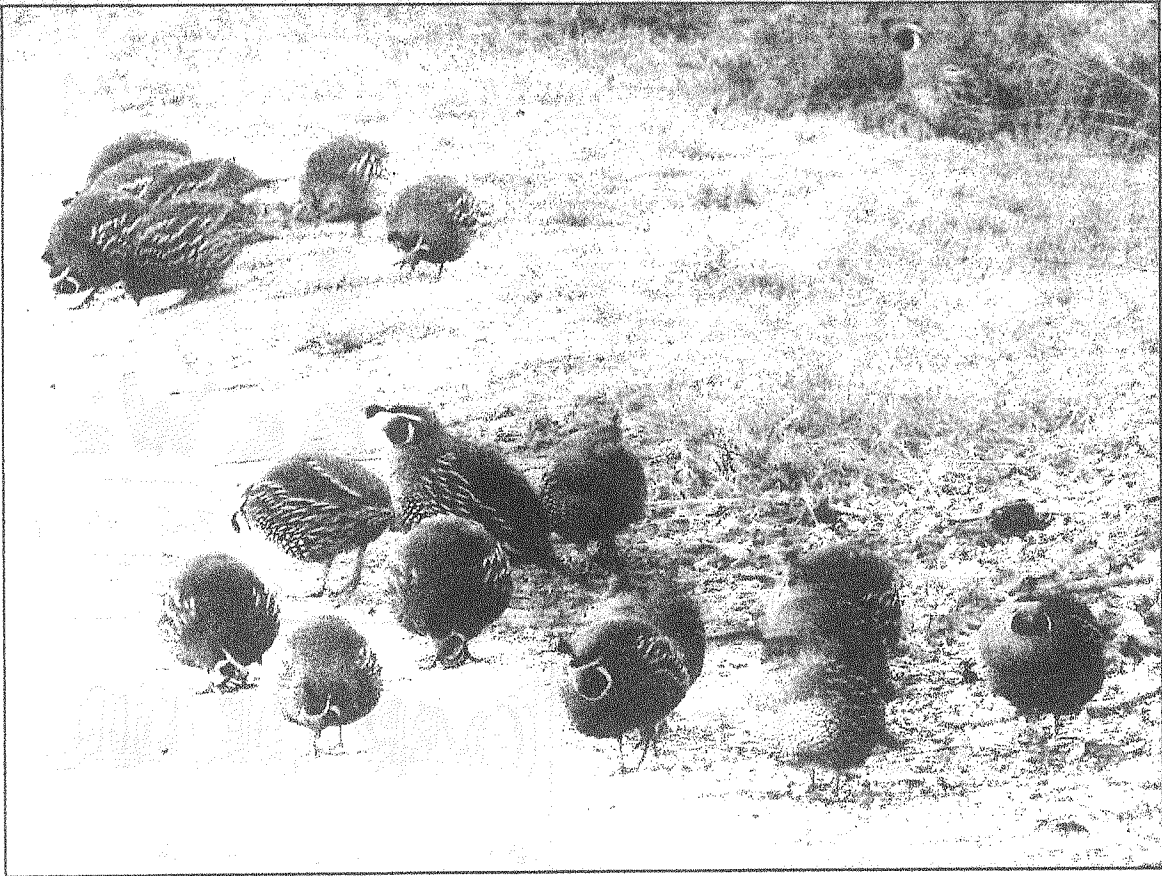

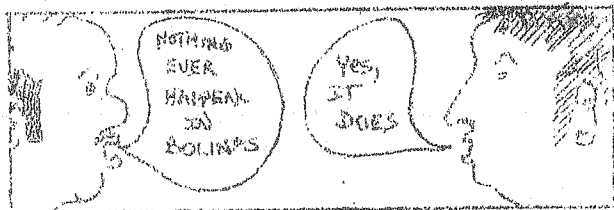
### BAD NEWS
