
Just wanted to share my last thoughts on the Freebox Follies. One of the reasons it happens as it does is that I make it my full time job. While I sew, each outfit puts itself together and tells me what it wants to be, and that keeps me focused on possibility. Each magic appearance of a willing person or a serendipitous material arriving at the perfect moment or calling my attention is a delight. Someone willing to come on stage for the first time in the community is a delight."

The Freebox Follies is the Freebox personified on a stage. I am holding a container for whatever medicine others have in themselves, it is a big job, when it is not terrifying and I do not think it is way over my head to do what I am doing I am delighted.

The night of the show I am still wondering if we can pull all this folly/experimental theatre off, sometimes I become worried it is getting too far into folly (or has wandered into that further realm which is chaos). At those moments I have been back stage and listened to the sound of our community receiving all that miscellaneous medicine, all that incredible naked Freeboxing , And what I hear is that same delight that has been visiting me as I diligently dedicated myself the the totally unreasonable idea of doing a show without being attached to who and how it benefits. I hear our community receiving the medicine of our own generosity. And all over again I am delighted. It is not "my show" but I wanted to express how I hold it possible and why I am willing to do it. It is because it is full of miracles and there is only one community I could even imagine it to be possible in.
