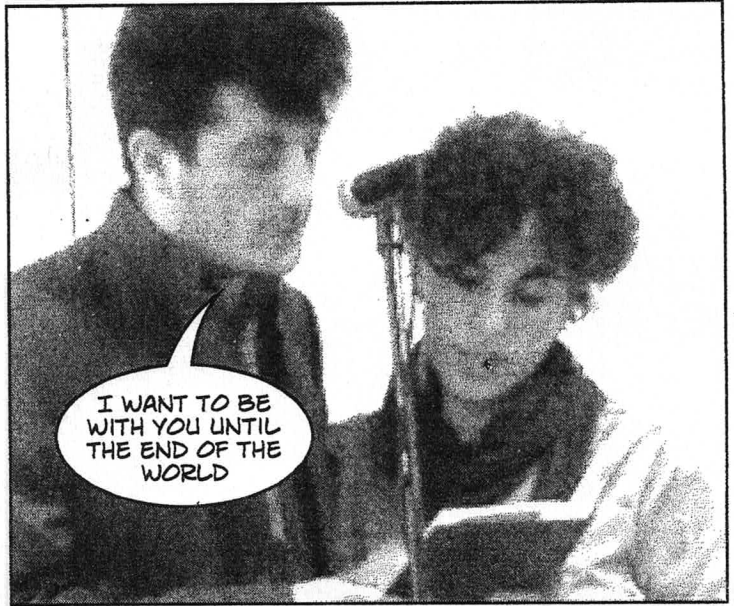

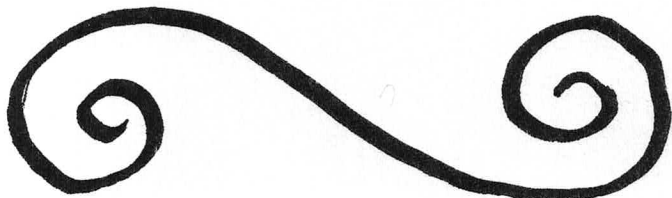

We walked to the meadow overlooking the ocean. The sea fog began to break away to the moon. Stars began to flash their brilliance in a night-time sky. I saw transcendence, and felt the love of good friends. It was a fine New Year's Eve.
