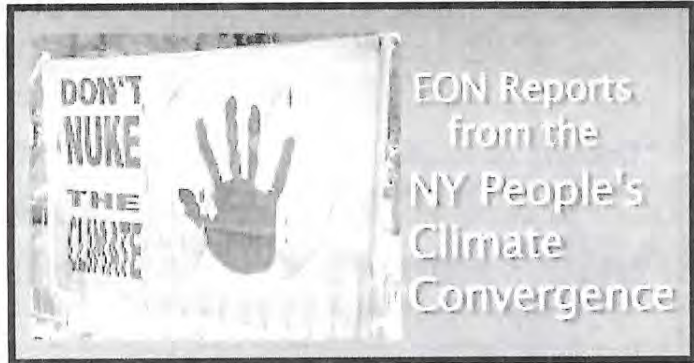

The health and happiness of people in a community is important for its strength and sustainability. The wellbeing of West Marin is looked after by the Friends of Sam's House.

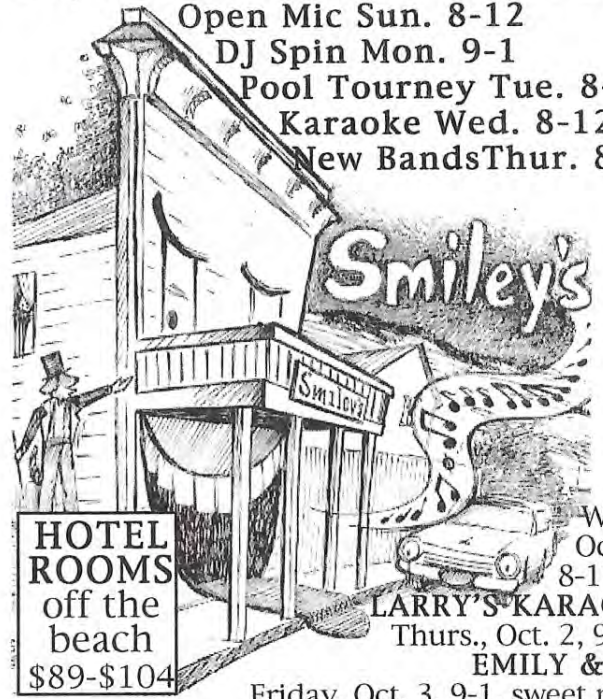

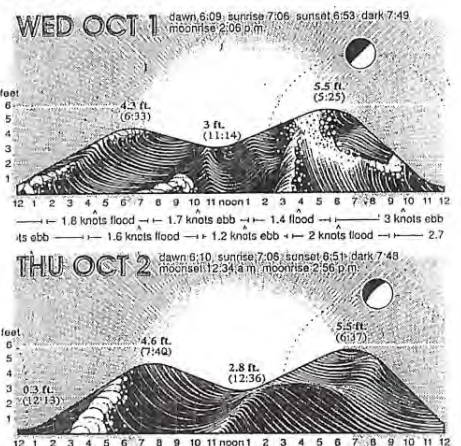
SARAH CAHILL: PIANO CONCERT SERIES

We may recognize them as our constant companions who flow in the rivers of our unexplored and often silent being.

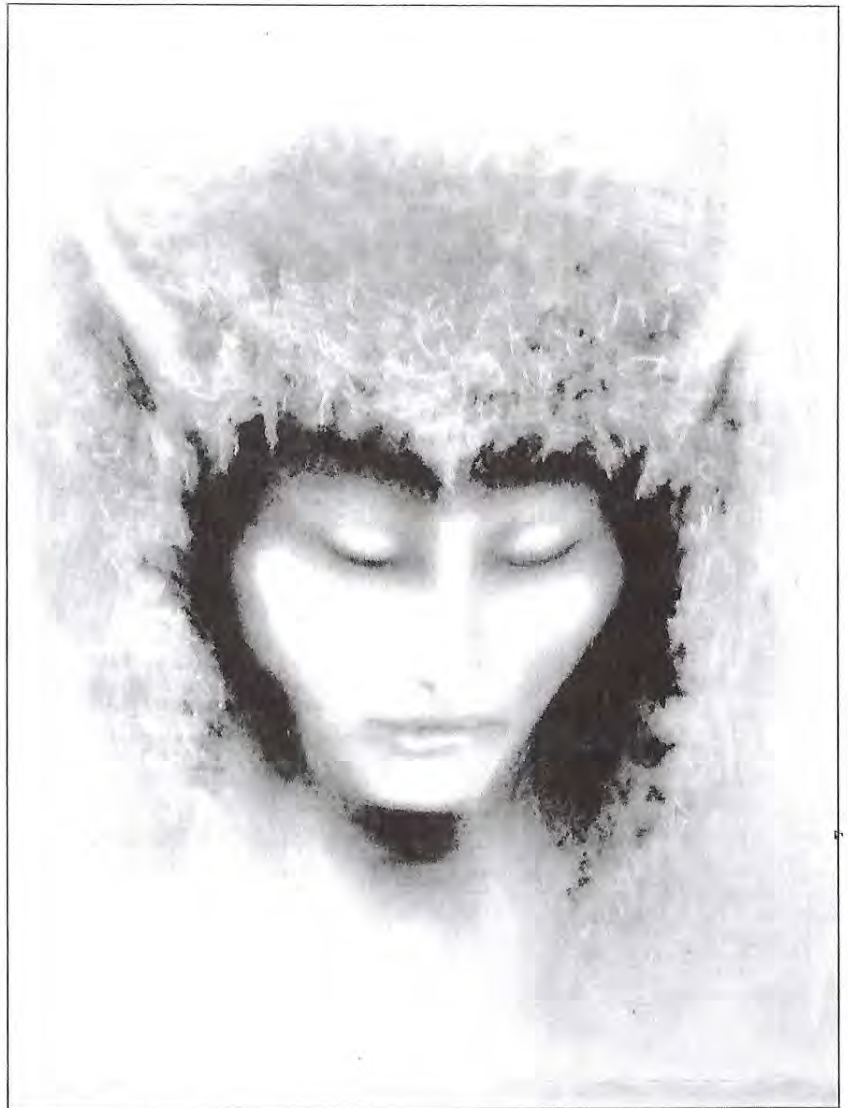

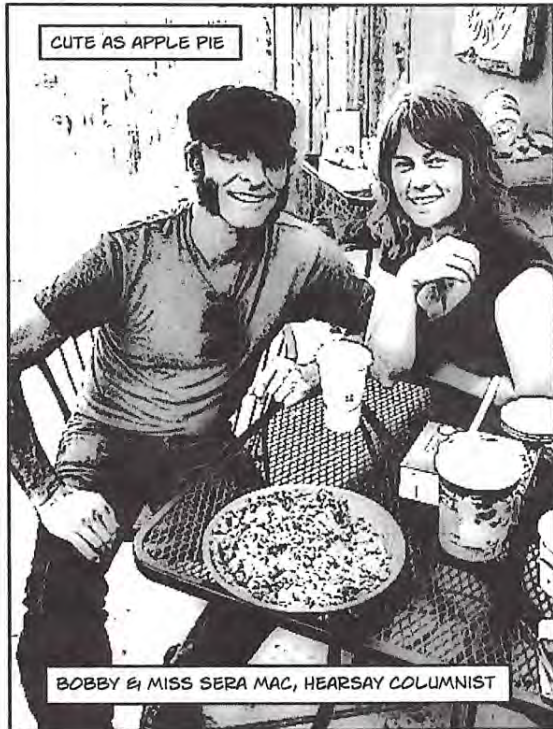

Seniors often wind up living alone in a big, empty house, a situation which causes a host of problems. Leslie brings people together to share housing for mutual benefit.

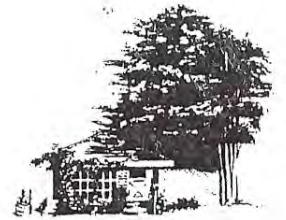
