## Czapski & Karpeles

This Friday, 7pm, at Pt. Reyes Books

Eric Karpeles will be talking with Steve Heilig about his two new books: *Almost Nothing, the 20th-Century Art and Life of Josef Czapski* and *Lost Time, Lectures on Proust in a Soviet Prison Camp* written by Josef Czapski and translated by Eric.

I wanted to know more and I asked Eric to tell the Hearsay how Josef Czapski had entered his life.

*"What drew me to Josef Czapski initially was his relationship to art. He was a painter and I am a painter. But we also had a connection through Proust. My artbook on Proust "Paintings in Proust" was printed in 2008. Someone who read the book gave me a call and said she knew another painter who wrote about Proust. His name was Josef Czapski."*

*"One day in 2012 I received a book in the mail. It was in French and titled "Lost Time: Lectures on Proust in a Soviet Prison Camp" by Josef Czapski. It was only 100 pages. I thought to myself that I should translate the book because other people would enjoy it."*

*"I thought it would only take me a few weeks, and that initial work did take only a few weeks. But as I was translating "Lost Time" I became intrigued by Czapski, a Polish painter in a Soviet Prison Camp, freezing, starving, overworked. What made him decide to lecture his fellow inmates on Proust?"*

*Books were forbidden in the prison camp. Czapski had no text so he had to recall his Proust from memory. By doing this he was actually recreating the Proustian endeavor - which is to remember.*

*After translating Czapski's lectures I wanted to write about his life. That part took six years in the making, all of it here in Bolinas."*

*"I had to get the permission of a Polish literary critic in order to gain access to Czapski's archives, his family, etc. I proposed to the critic at that time that I would write 3 books about Czapski: a translation of his lectures on Proust, a biography of his life as a painter, and an artbook of his paintings.*

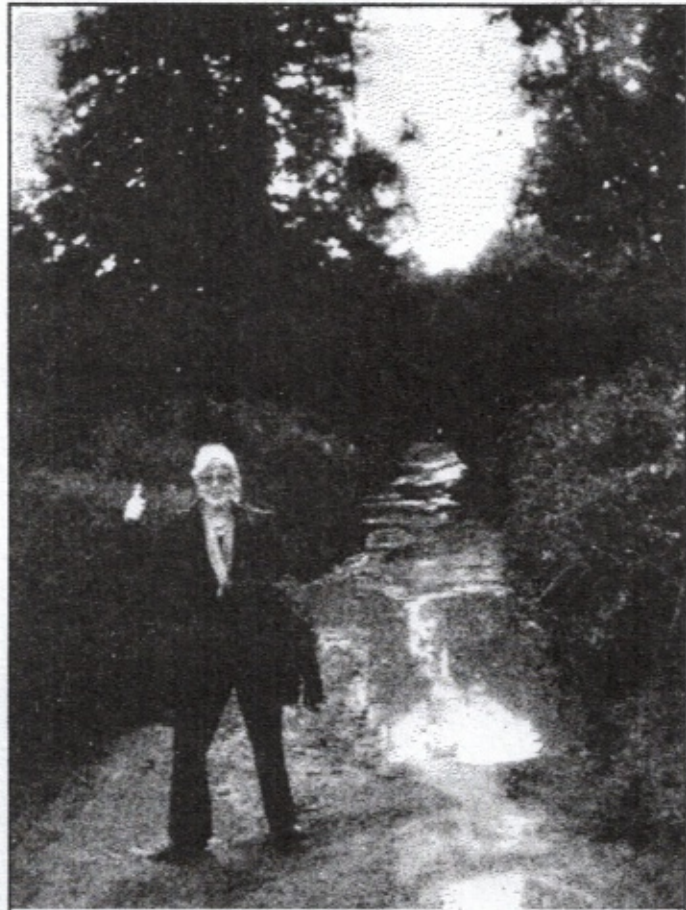
*Years later the same critic told me that he thought to himself at the time, 'Sure, good luck to that'*

*Now two of the books have been published and the third will be out next September."*

*"The fact that I didn't speak Polish was a stumbling block when I began the book on Czapski, but I realized I could take 2 or 3 years to learn Polish or I could jump right in and start researching."*

*"Josef Czapski spoke 4 languages and I speak 2, but I realized that we shared yet another language — the language of painting."*

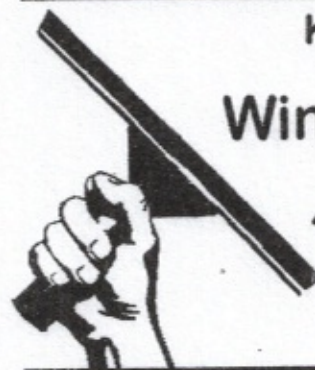

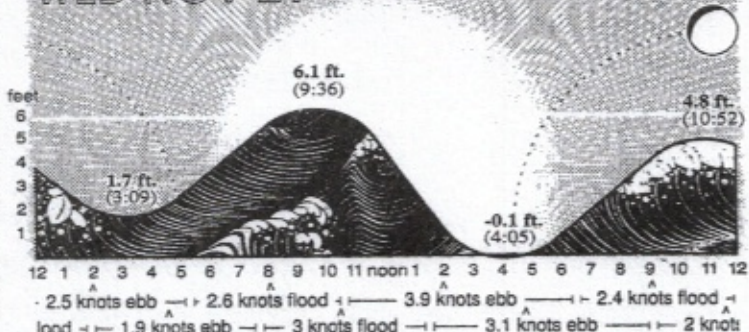

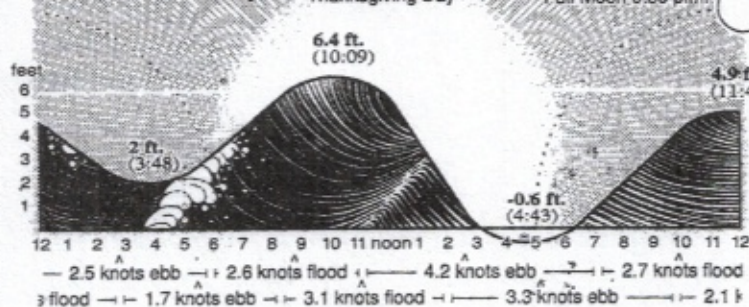
