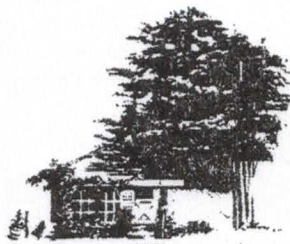
Indigenous communities around the world and in the U.S. are resisting threats to their sacred places—the original protected lands—in a growing movement to defend human rights and restore the environment.

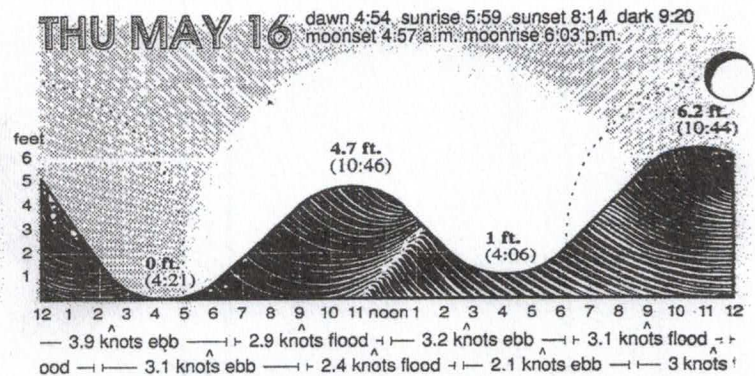
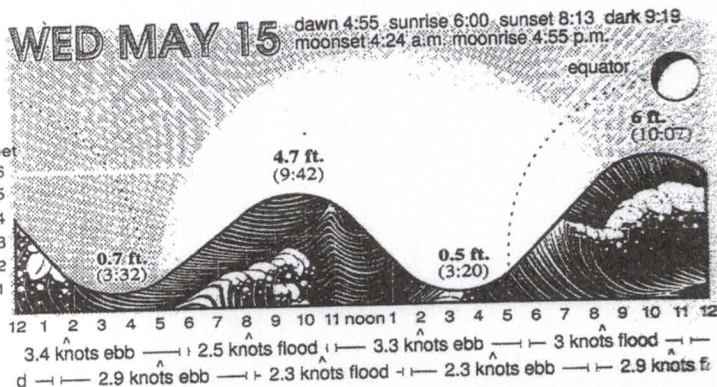
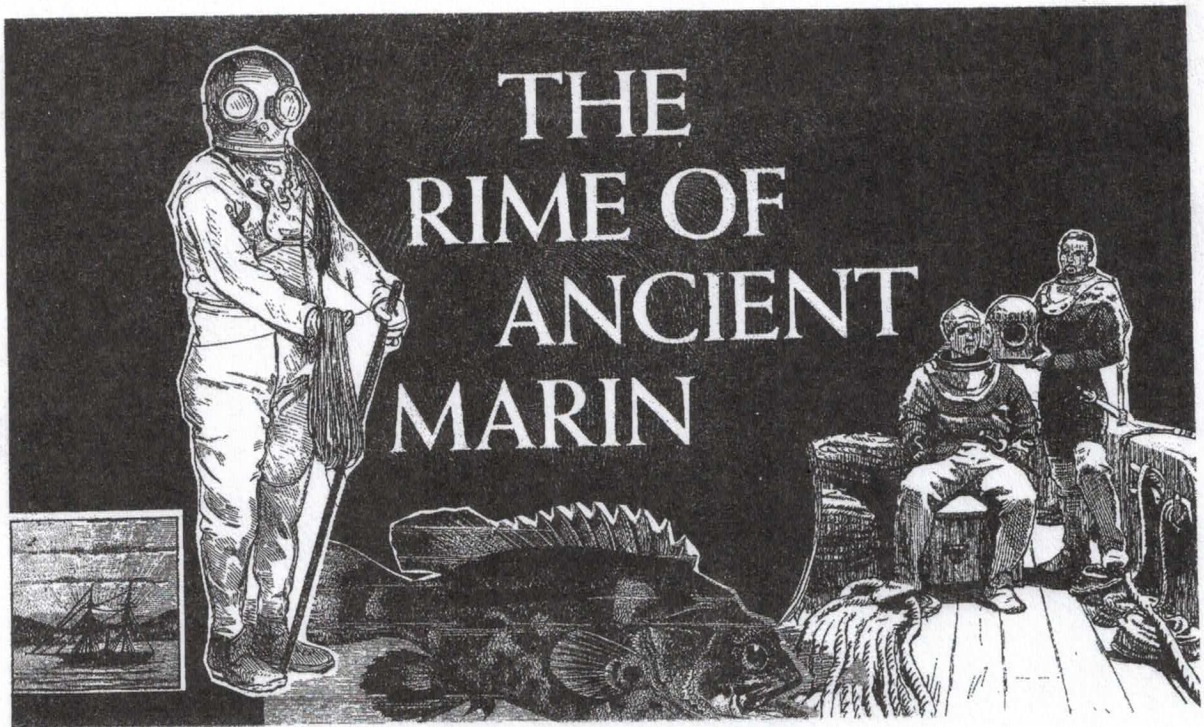

William Stanley Merwin passed on April 15. Merwin was the 17<sup>th</sup> Poet Laureate of the United States in 2010 and twice won the Pulitzer Prize for poetry. A number of years ago Eric Karpeles convinced Merwin to leave his hideaway on Maui and come to Commonweal for a talk at the New School. It was an inspiring talk characterized by Buddhist philosophy and deep ecology. (a drawing from that time became a constant reminder of the Divine Feminine) A week ago a poem of Merwin's appeared on the reading table at the Bookstore. Seemed appropriate to include both the found poem and the drawing in a Hearsay Homage to W. S. Merwin

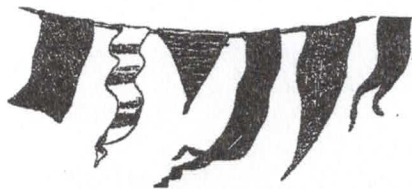

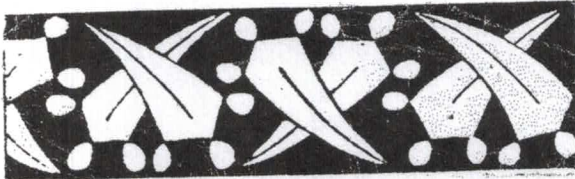

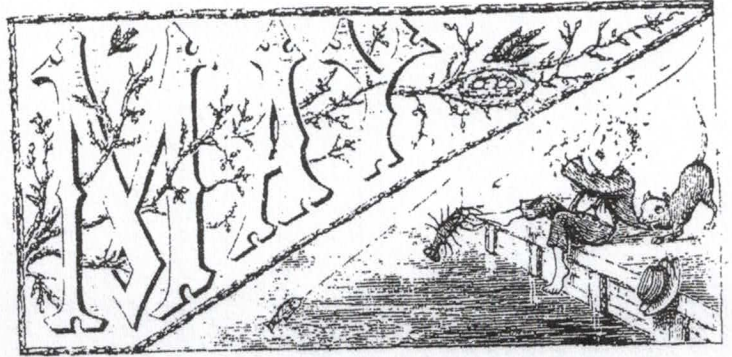
