

### Hardware Store Parking News

Dear Bolinas Neighbors and Friends,

We understand that parking can be a nightmare on weekends these days in Bolinas. But it's even worse if you're a business owner trying to keep people out of your few spots so actual customers can shop in your store.

We have tried to help people out when they need to do a quick errand in town on the weekends, but unfortunately, last weekend turned into a complete fiasco and this is not a one-time event. A local employee chose to leave their car right in front of our store all day, people doing their laundry parked there and there were many cars in our back lot and we had no idea to whom they belonged. One person from Oregon came to me and said that his friend told him we offer parking in our back lot. Really? Someone's truck with a camper shell was there all day and we had to close it in because the owner hadn't returned by 5, I have no idea whose that was. We had to chase down other parkers to remind them to leave by 5 pm. All this made it a very stressful day and difficult to do my actual job.

Because of all this, we will no longer be able to offer parking in our back lot and hope that people will try and respect that and also that parking in our front lot is for customers while they are shopping only. We are not able to accommodate your parties or sporting events with parking. Please don't buy something and then assume you can stay in the front lot to do other errands unless you have permission and don't plan on staying long.

I spoke with the sheriff about towing the car that was in our front lot all day and he said that we have to have lots of large Marin County No Parking signs that have specific ordinance numbers on them. Now I have to purchase those and hang them all over our fence, obscuring the lovely signs that were created for us by the Bolinas Summer Camp last year. I'm sorry that a few people have spoiled this asset for many, but there is just too much liability and stress involved with what started out as a couple of folks needing parking to go to church on Sunday. I suggest that anyone who is as frustrated as I am with the town parking write to Supervisor Rodoni and anyone else you can think of to create a local parking permit or some kind of solution to this terrible problem in our town.









