
## BAD NEWS

## RECIPE

### OYSTERS OVER RICE for two.

Fry one jar of oysters in butter until the edges curl. Add one heaping teaspoon chicken stock base (or 3 bullion cubes), some pepper, 1tsp soy sauce, and 1/2 tsp sweet basil. Stir. Add 1cup white wine. Turn heat down and simmer until it no longer smells like wine (about 10 minutes). Thicken with 2 egg yolks. Serve over rice.


